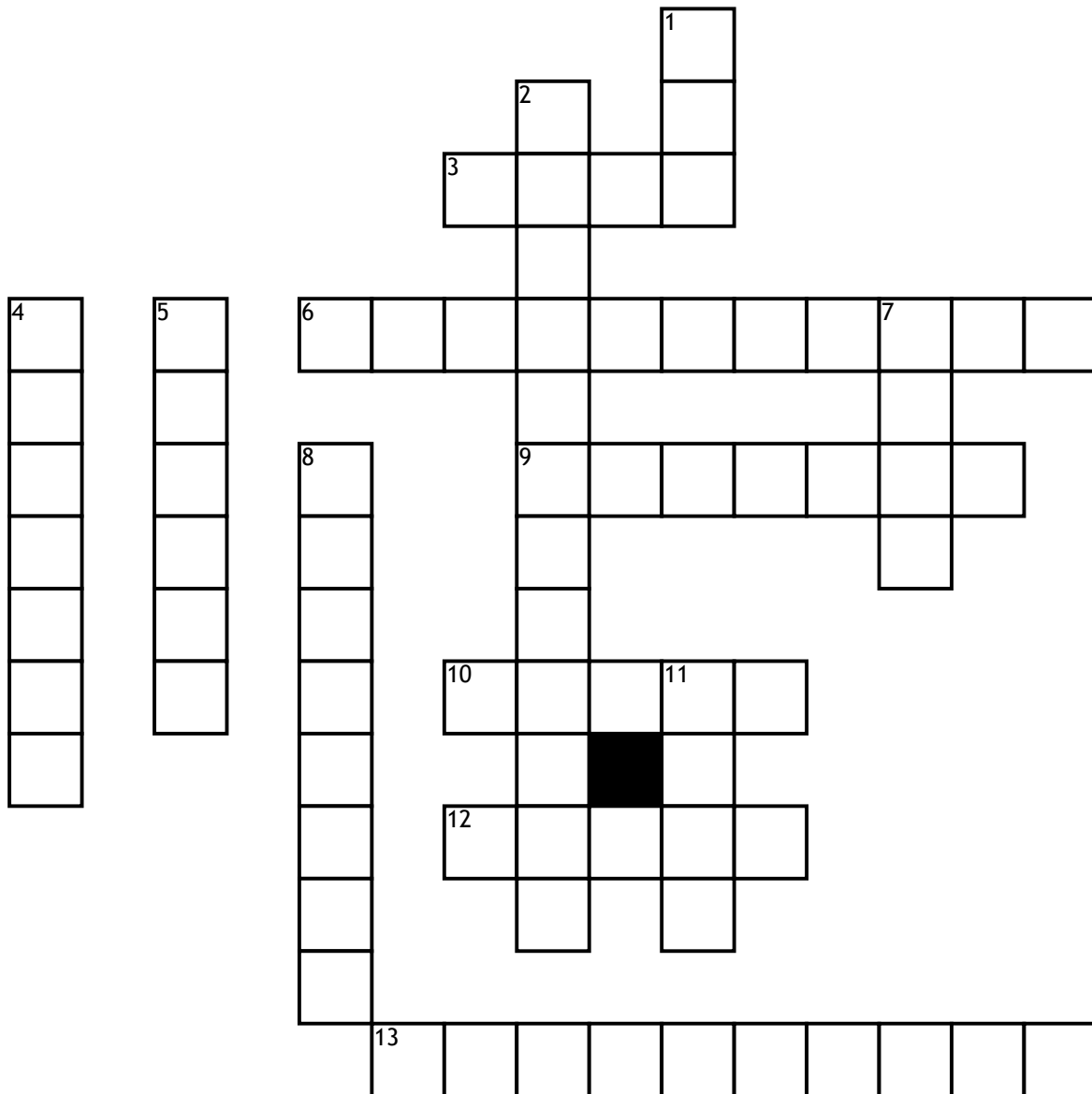

- 4. The prevailing style accepted and used by a particular group of people at a particular time.
- 5. A particular or unique version of a style.
- 7. Decorative additions to a garment.
- 8. Copy of an original design, mass produced, less expensive than the original.
- 11. An assortment of new designs offered by a manufacturer to its customers, usually on a seasonal basis.
