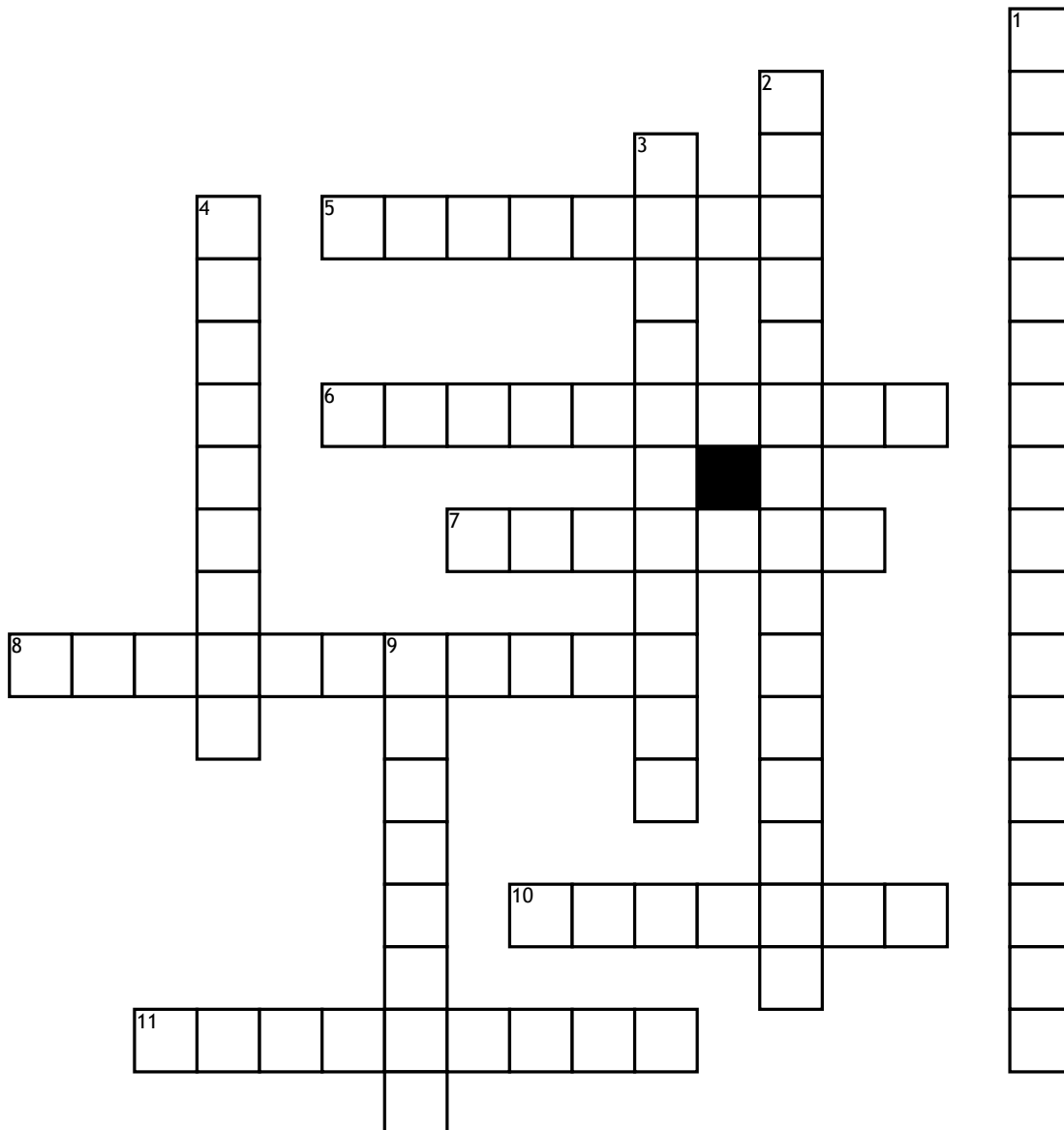

## Across

5. Powers that naturally belong to any government of a sovereign country
6. Powers that the Constitution neither grants exclusively to the federal government nor denies to the states
7. Powers that are suggested by the expressed powers
8. Federal funds that can be used by a state or locality in a broadly defined area
10. Clause that states Congress can carry out acts related to its powers

11. Powers that the Constitution specifically grants to the federal government

1. Payments by the federal government to carry out specific activities
2. Group of people who opposed ratification of the Constitution
3. Group of people who favored ratification of the Constitution
4. Clause that states national law is superior to state law
