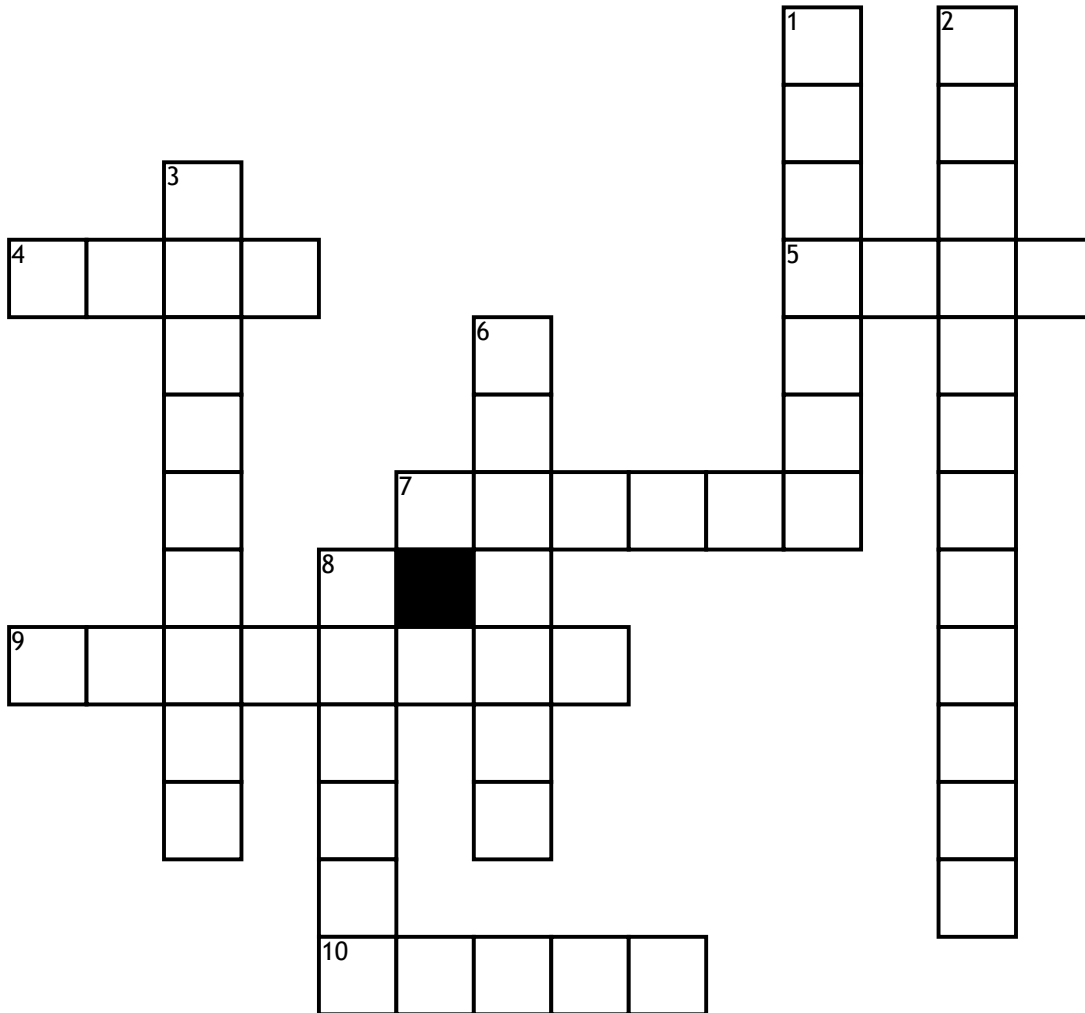


Feudalism in Western Europe
