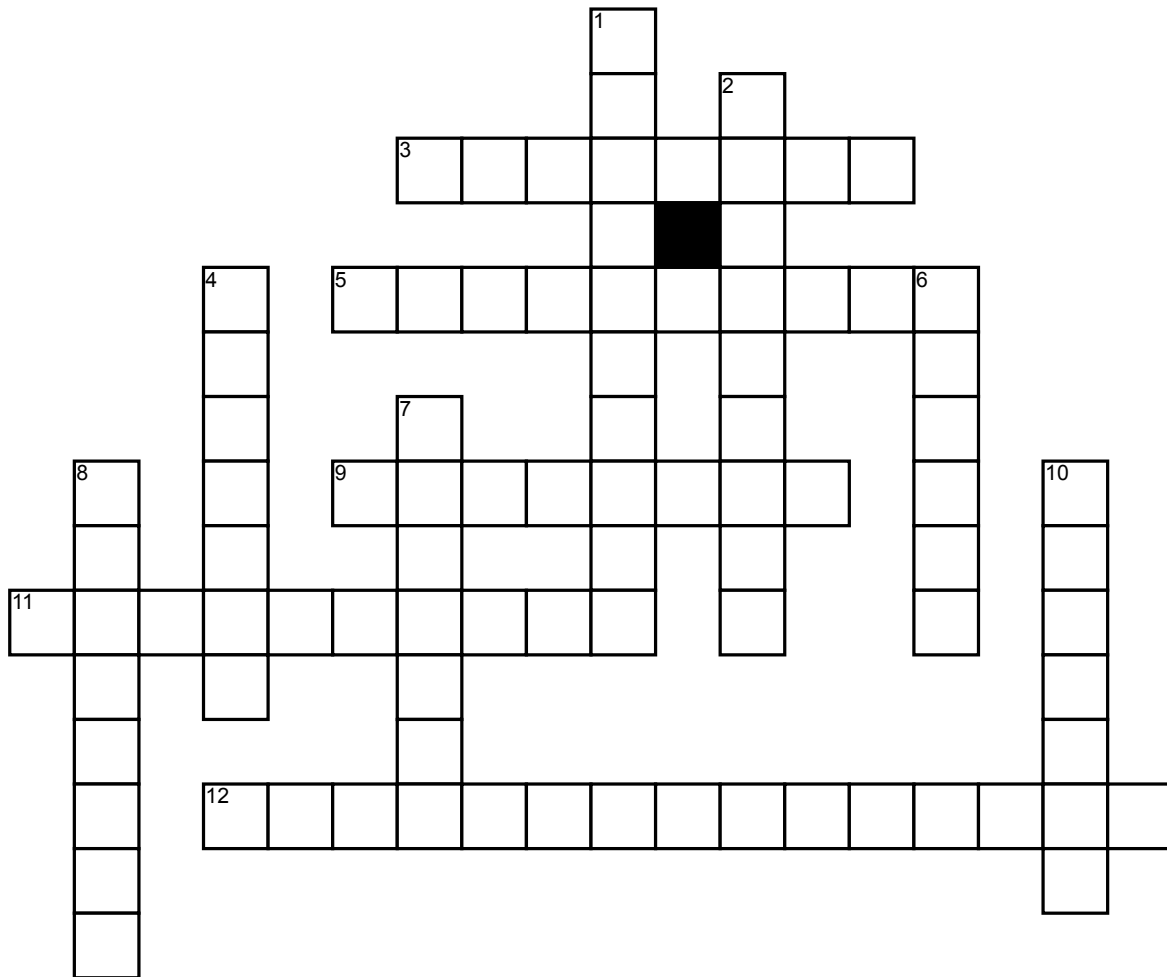


Figurative Language Crossword
