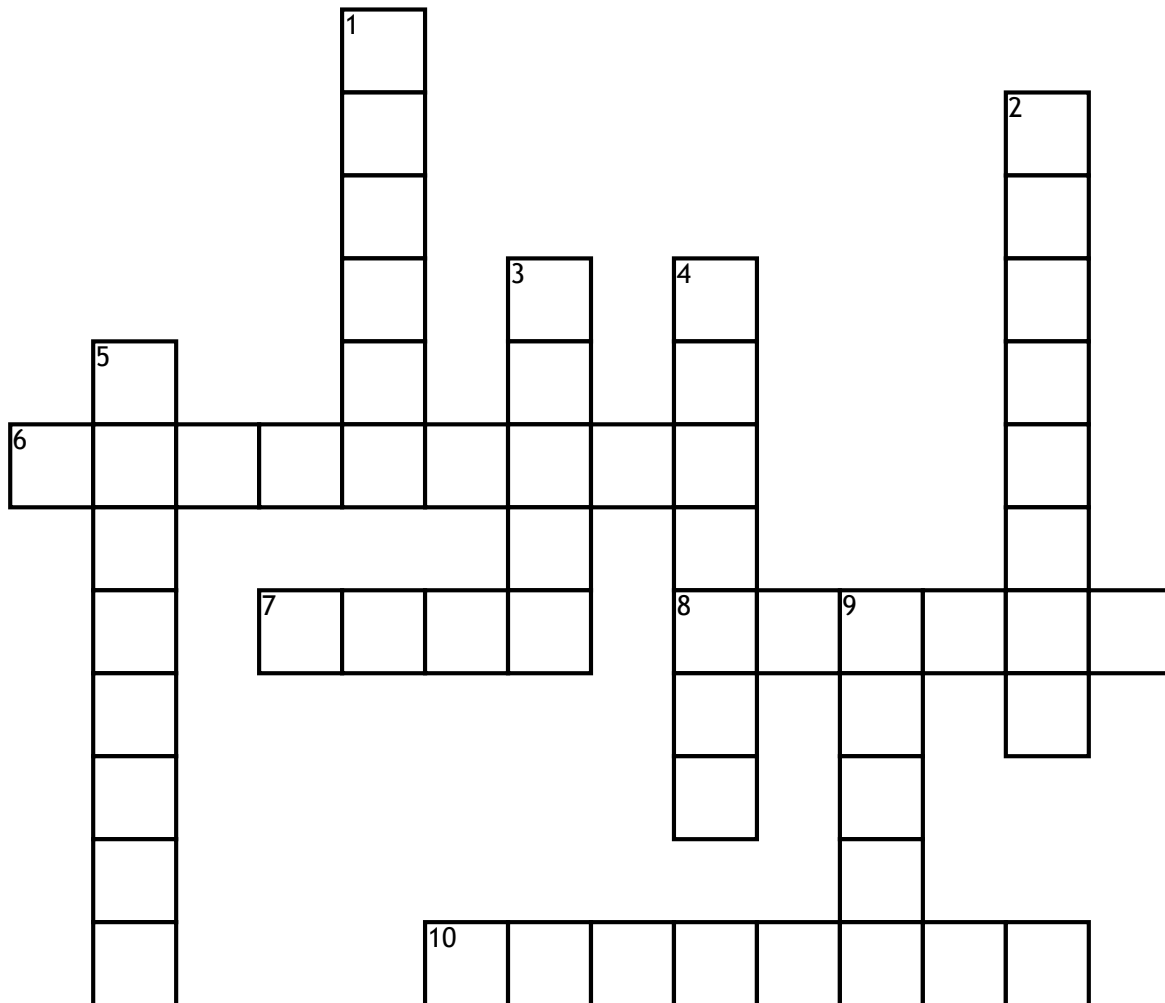


Finance Crossword 2018
