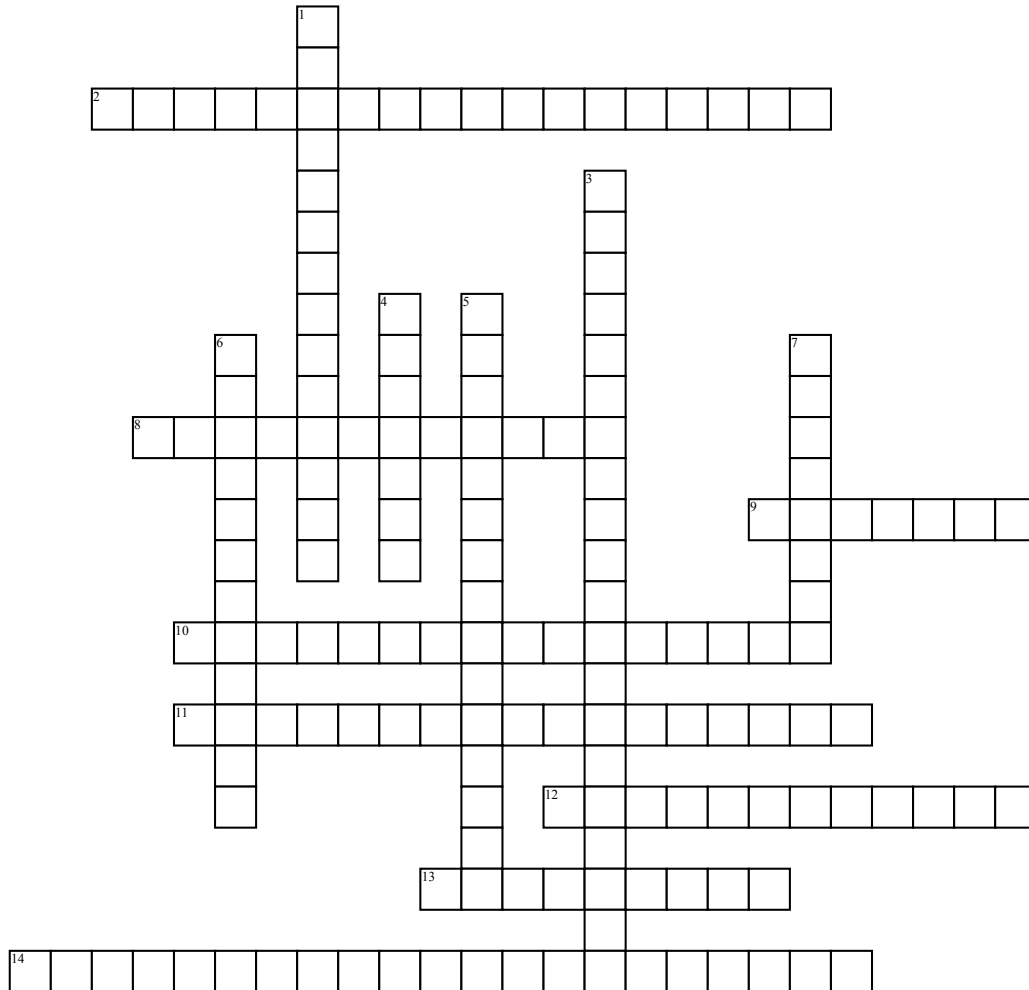


Finance Crossword Puzzle
