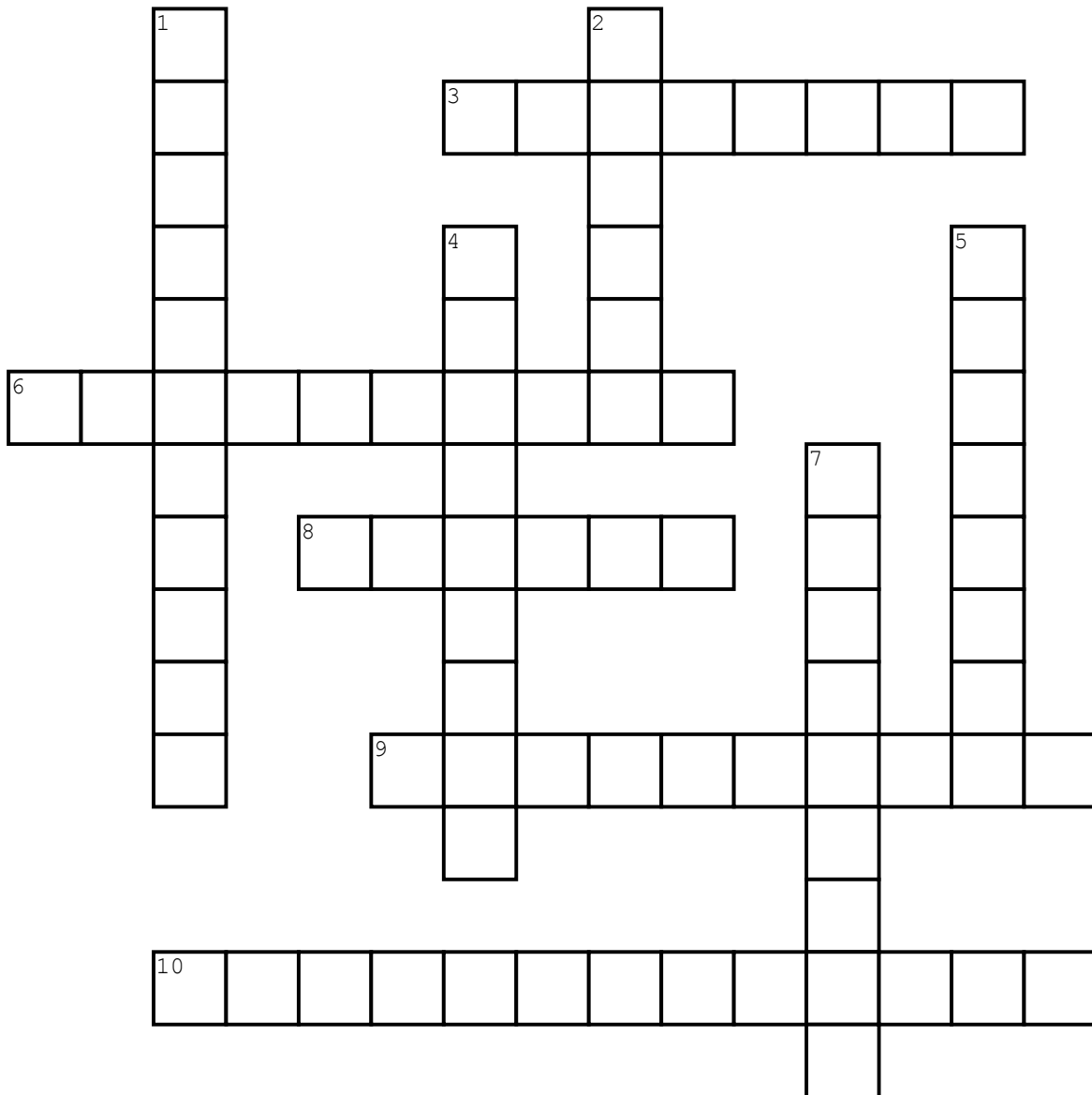


# Financial Algebra
