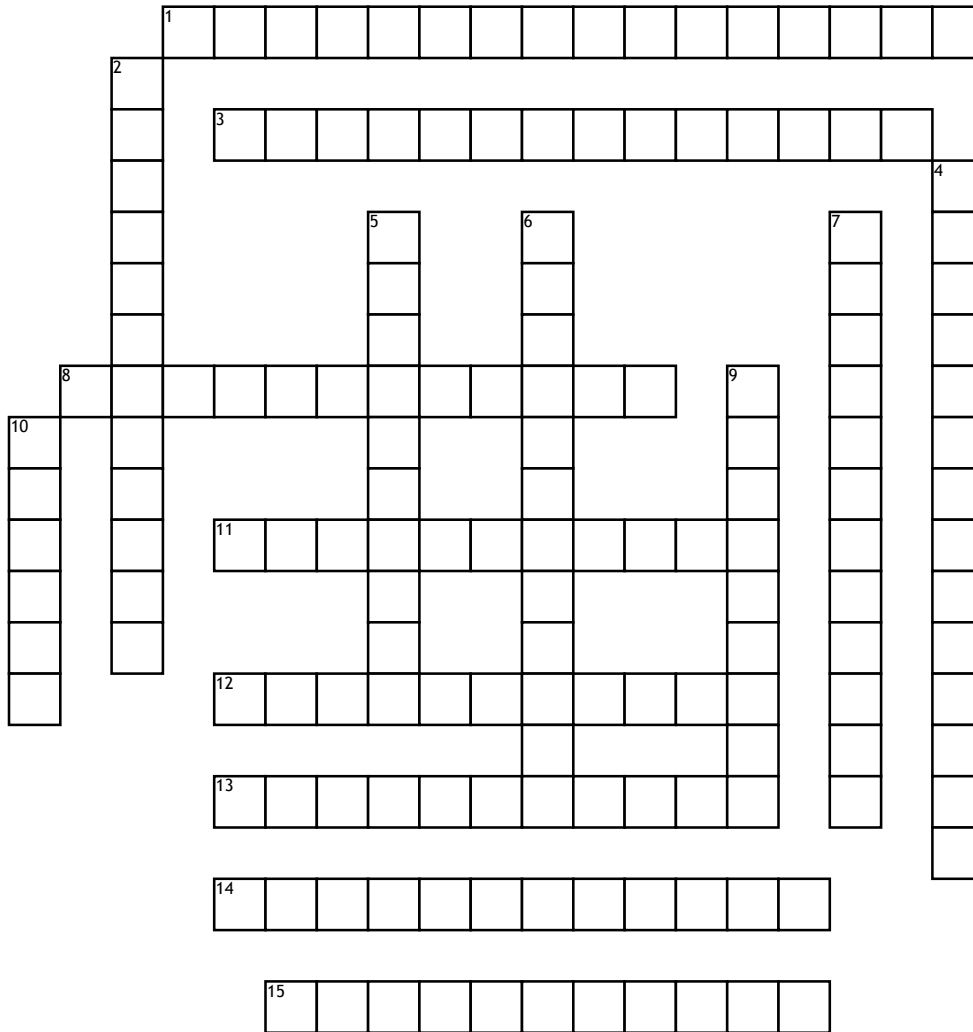


First Project Crossword Puzzle
