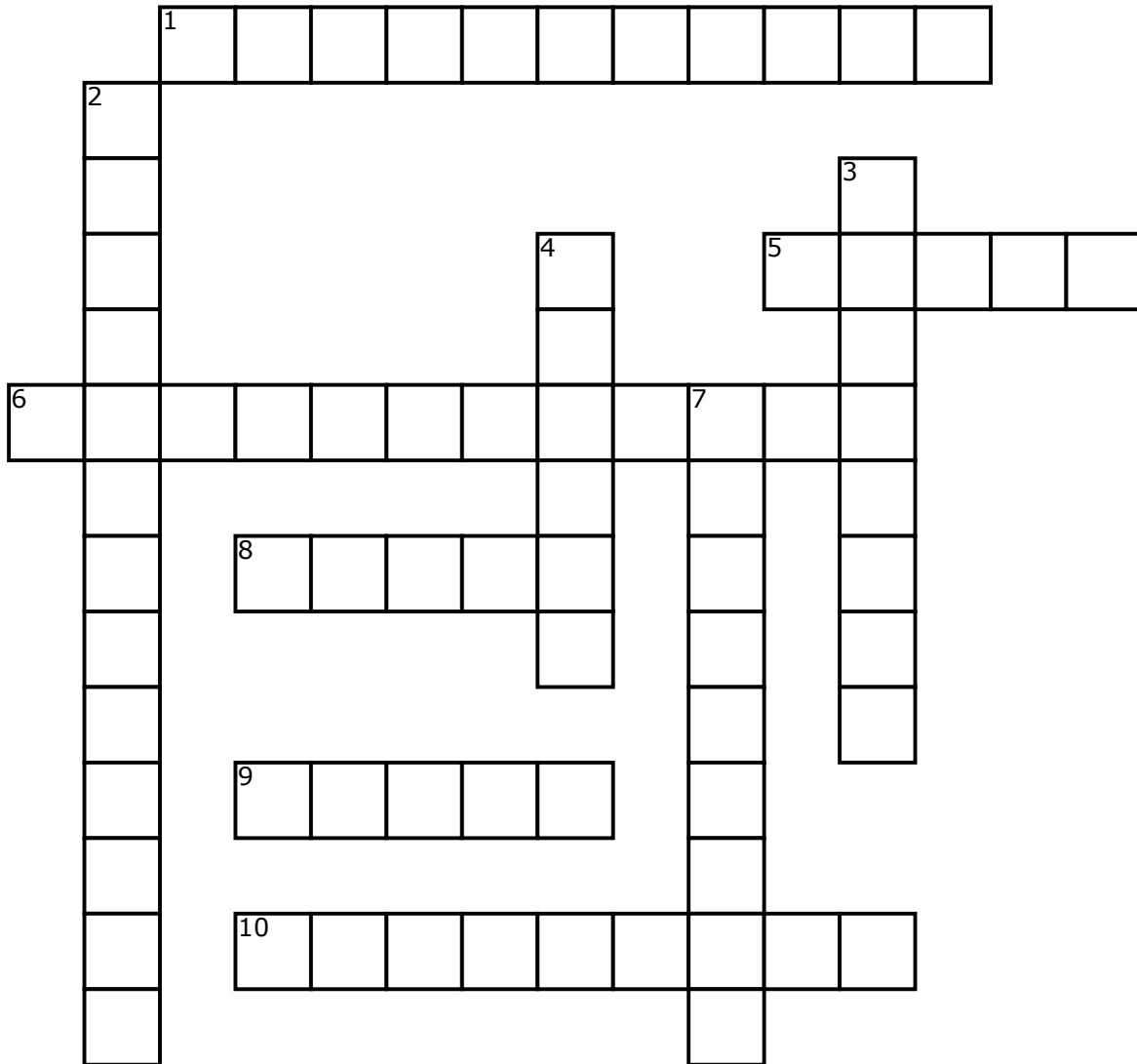


Fluid and Electrolytes

1. stimulates distal tubules of the kidneys to reabsorb sodium and excrete potassium

5. accounts for 100 to 200 ml/day of fluid loss

6. accurate method of assessing fluid status

8. second line of defense to restore pH

10. passive process by which molecules of a solute move from an area of higher concentration to an area of lower concentration
