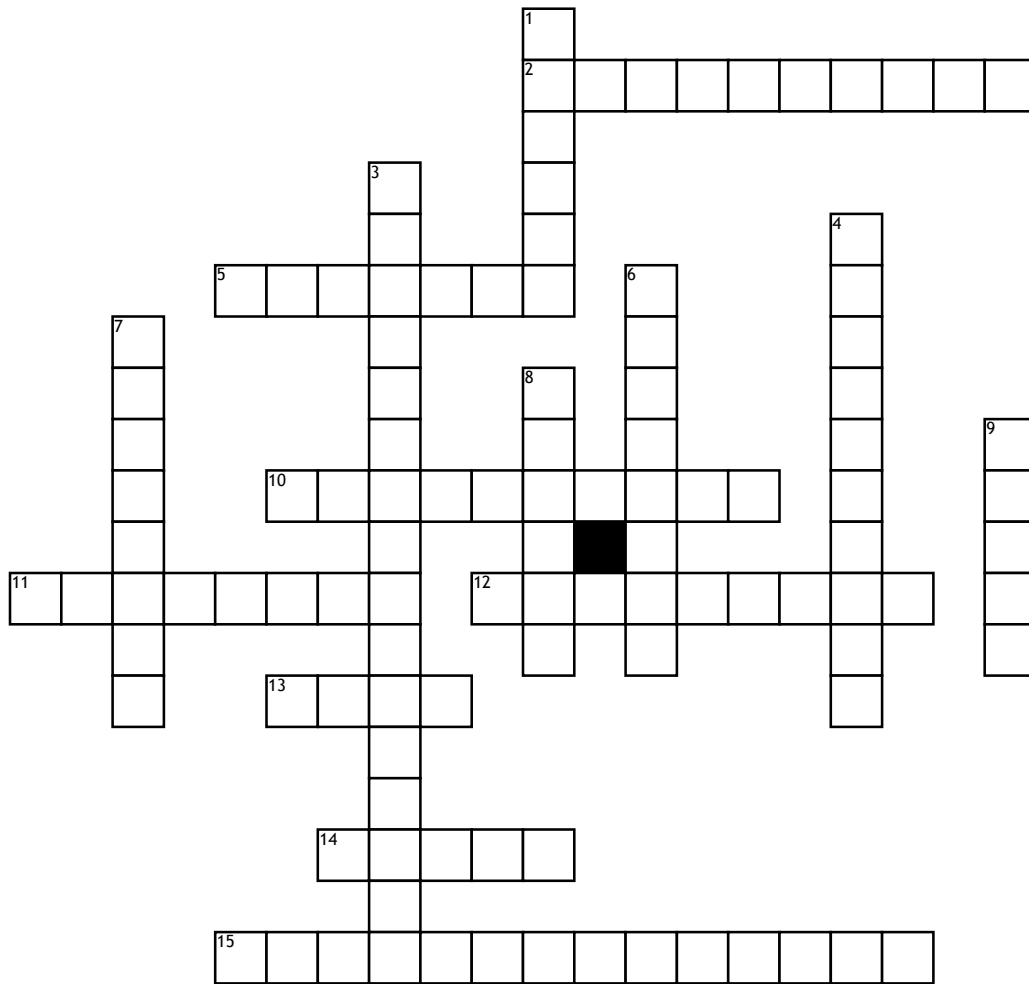


Food Safety Terminology

- 2. causing or capable of causing disease
- 5. bacteria that grow only in the presence of oxygen (environment)
- 10. mold that only grows on the exterior surface
- 11. need to live on or in a host to survive
- 12. bacteria that grow in the absence of oxygen (canned foods)

- 13. a multiple celled fungi that grows on organic matter and causes food spoilage
- 14. one celled fungi with both beneficial and pathogenic effects on food
- 15. mold that can penetrate the food surface 2 cm or more

Down

- 1. the dormant state of some bacterial cells, or the reproductive cell of a fungi; much more difficult to kill

- 3. an illness caused by eating food that has been contaminated in some way
- 4. the condition of food to be free from pathogens
- 6. a disease carrying microorganisms
- 7. single celled organism found in air, soil, water, and food
- 8. a collection of millions of micro-organisms, often visible with the naked eye
- 9. extremely resistant to heat and cold
