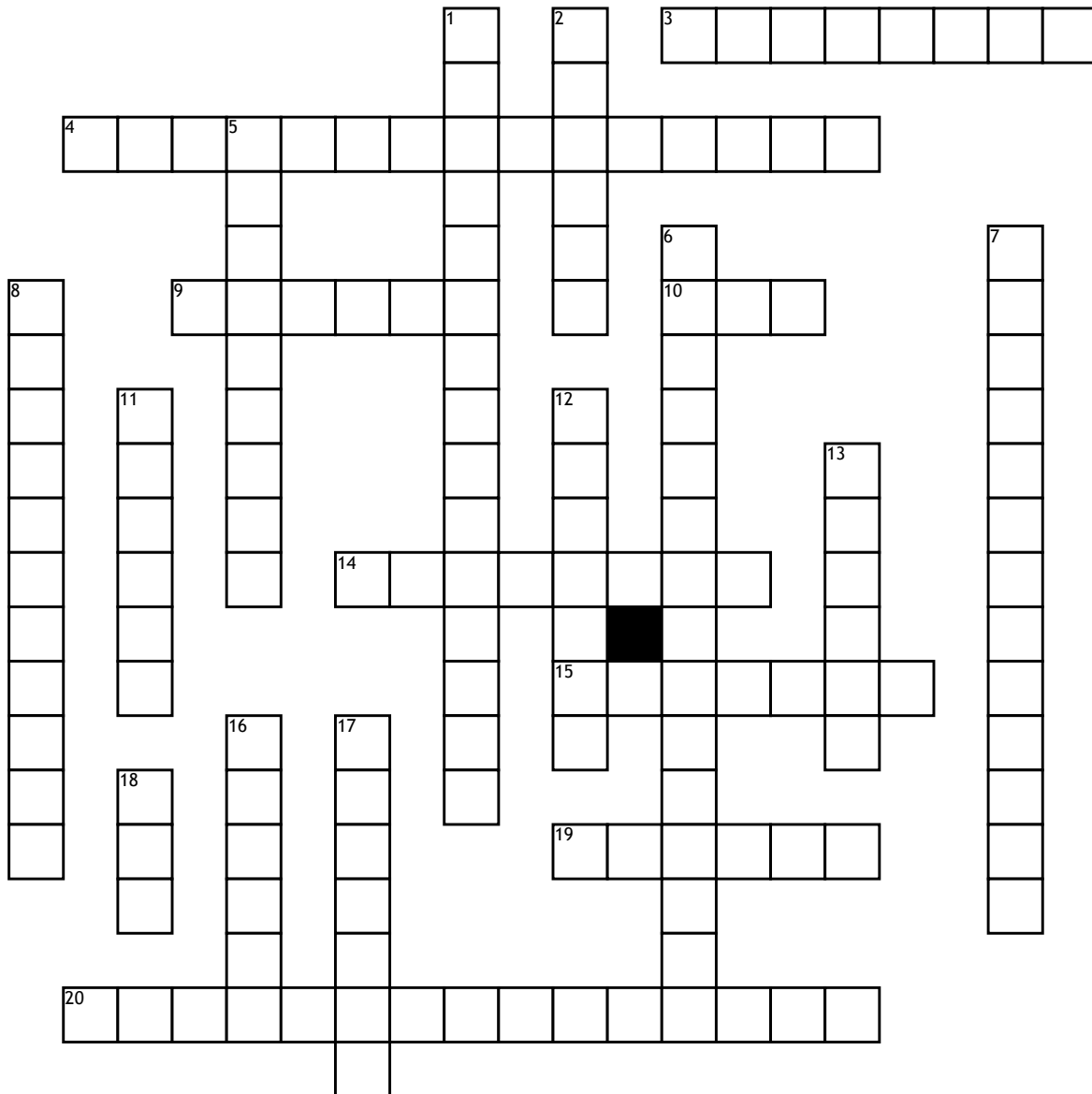

- 15. The side of the tooth adjacent to the tongue
- 19. The teeth that are third to the front
