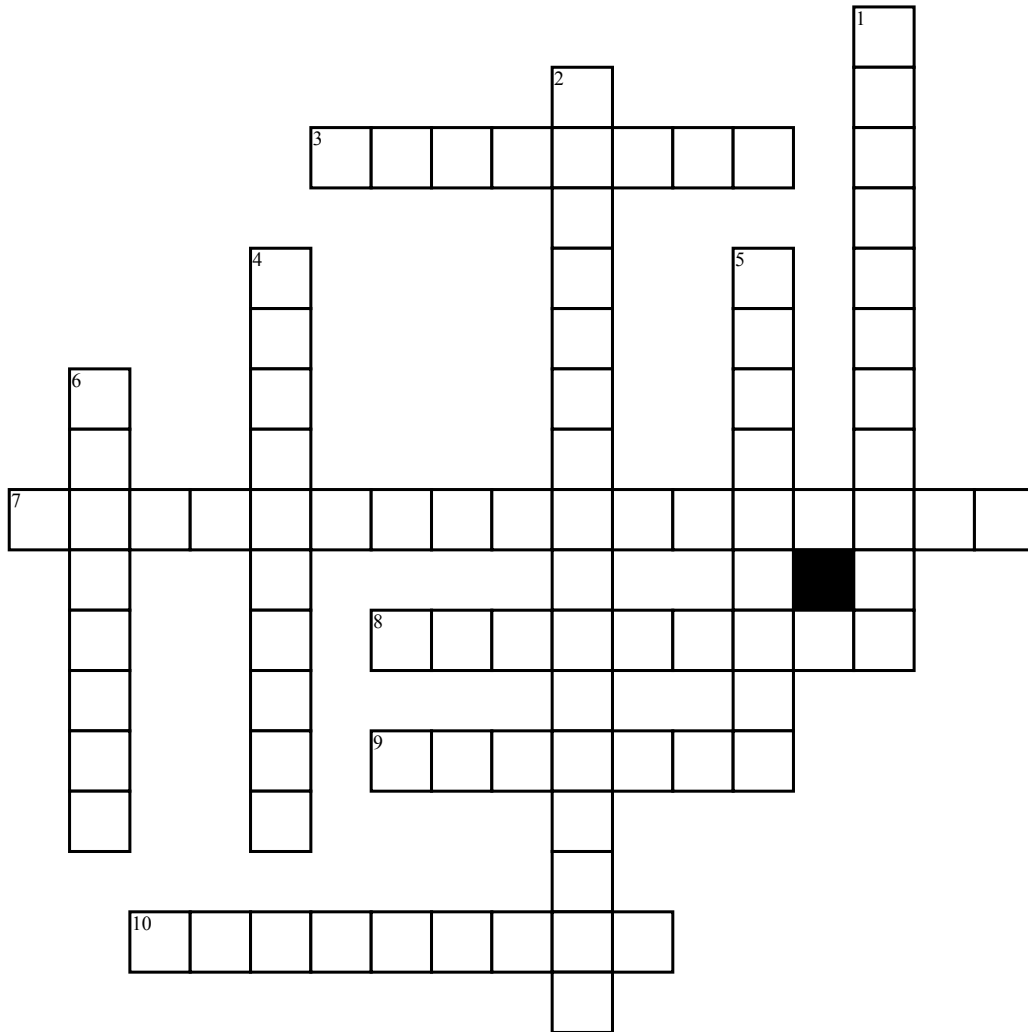


# Forms of Government



**Across**

- 3. A state in which the supreme power rests in the body of citizens entitled to vote and exercised by representatives chosen directly or indirectly by them (Rome)
- 7. Sometimes called, Representative Democracy, is when citizens elect representatives to make laws on their behalf.
- 8. A form of government in which God or a deity is recognized as the supreme civil ruler (Islamic Empire)
- 9. A government ruled by someone who uses power oppressively or unjustly (Assyrians)
- 10. "Government by the few", a form of government in which the supreme power is vested in a few people (Sparta)

**Down**

- 1. A government or state ruled by an elite or privileged upper class (India)
- 2. Not limited by laws or a constitution, all power (Egypt, Americas)
- 4. The governing body of a nation, state, or community.
- 5. "Government by the people", a form of government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised by them (Athens)
- 6. A form of autocracy where a state or nation in which the supreme power is actually held by a single person
