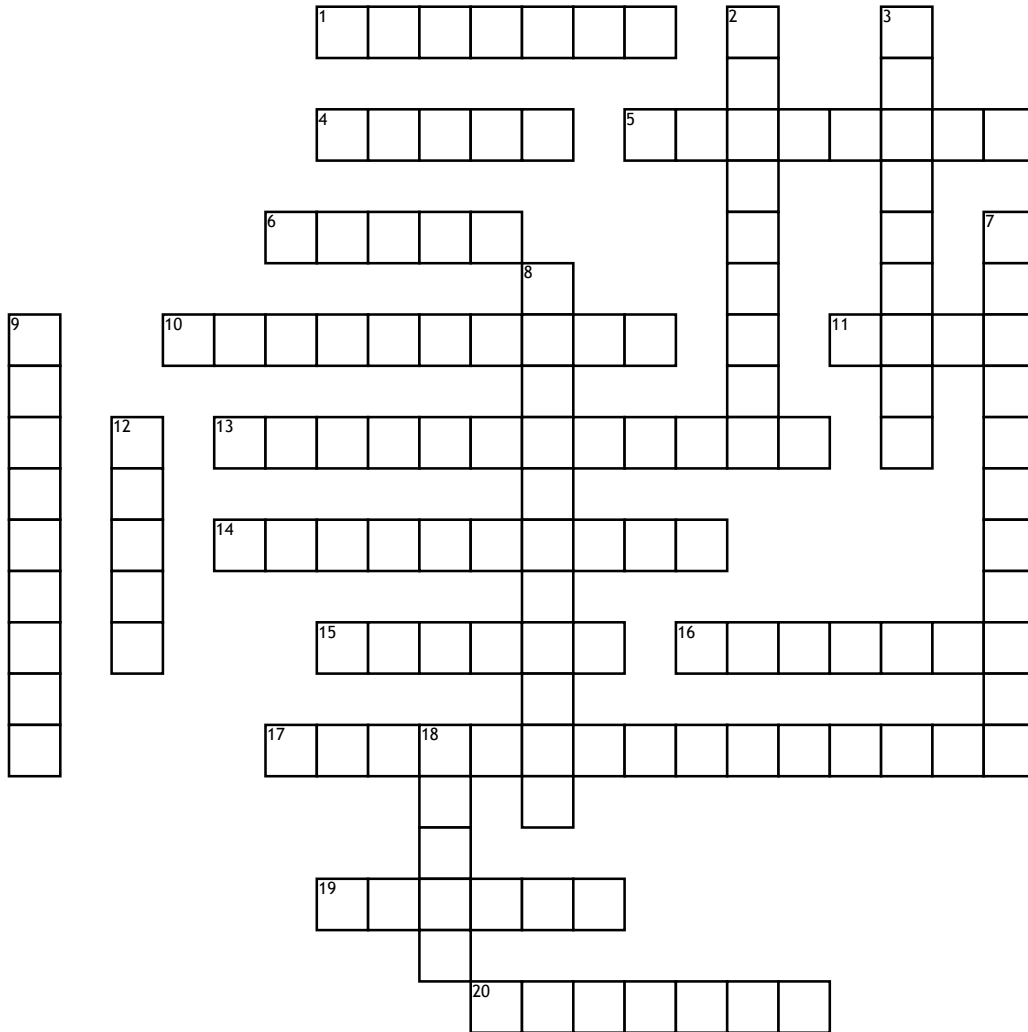


# France Crossword Puzzle
