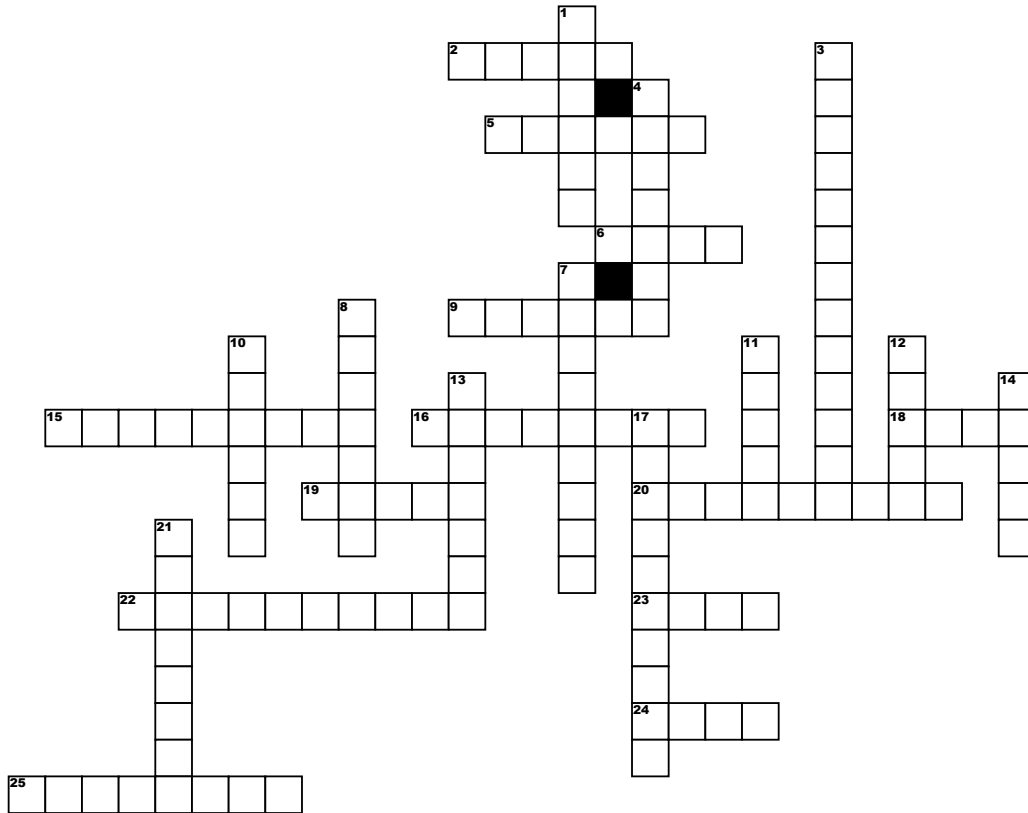


# Freak's Dictionary Puzzle
