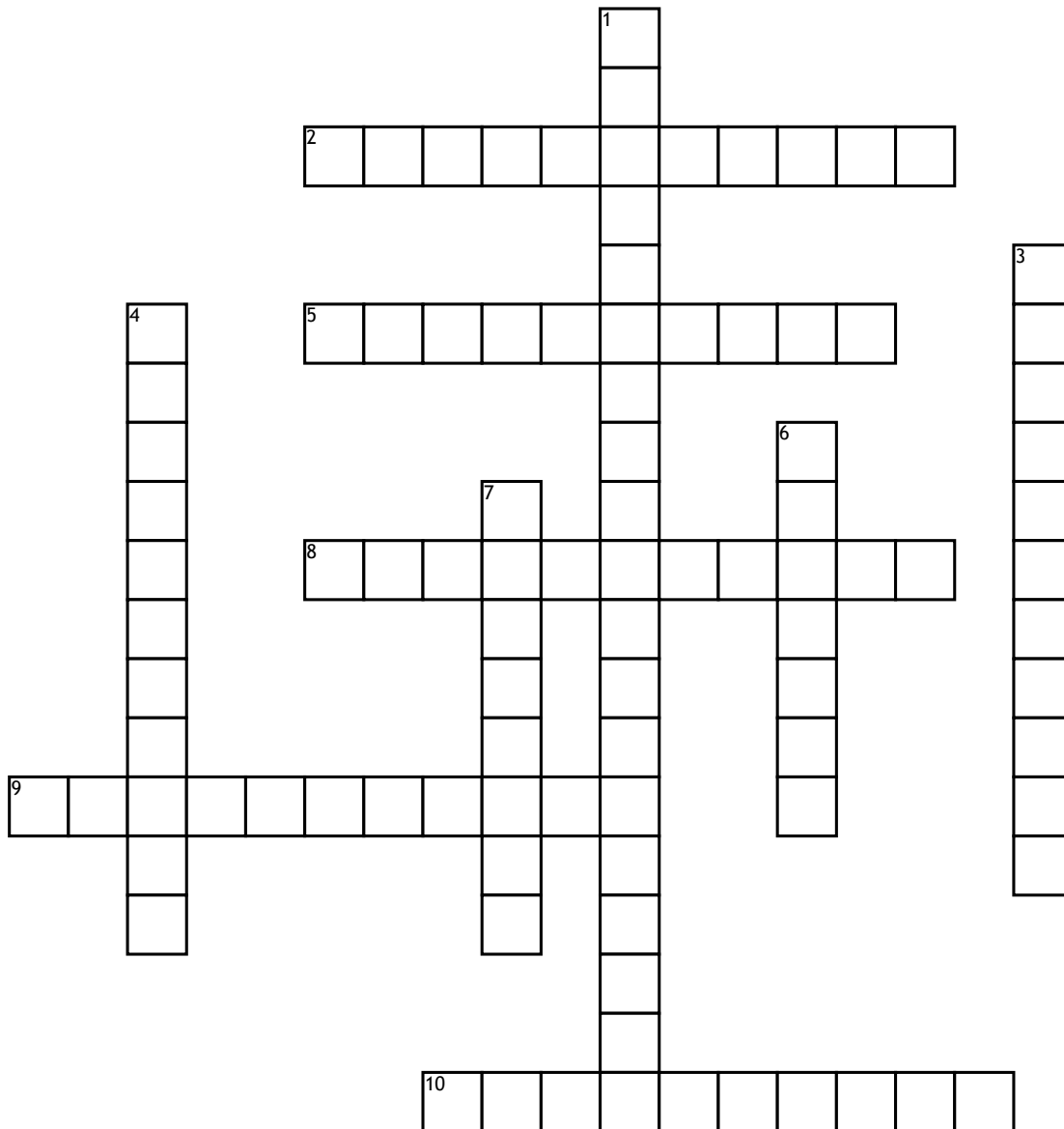


# Friendship Relationships
