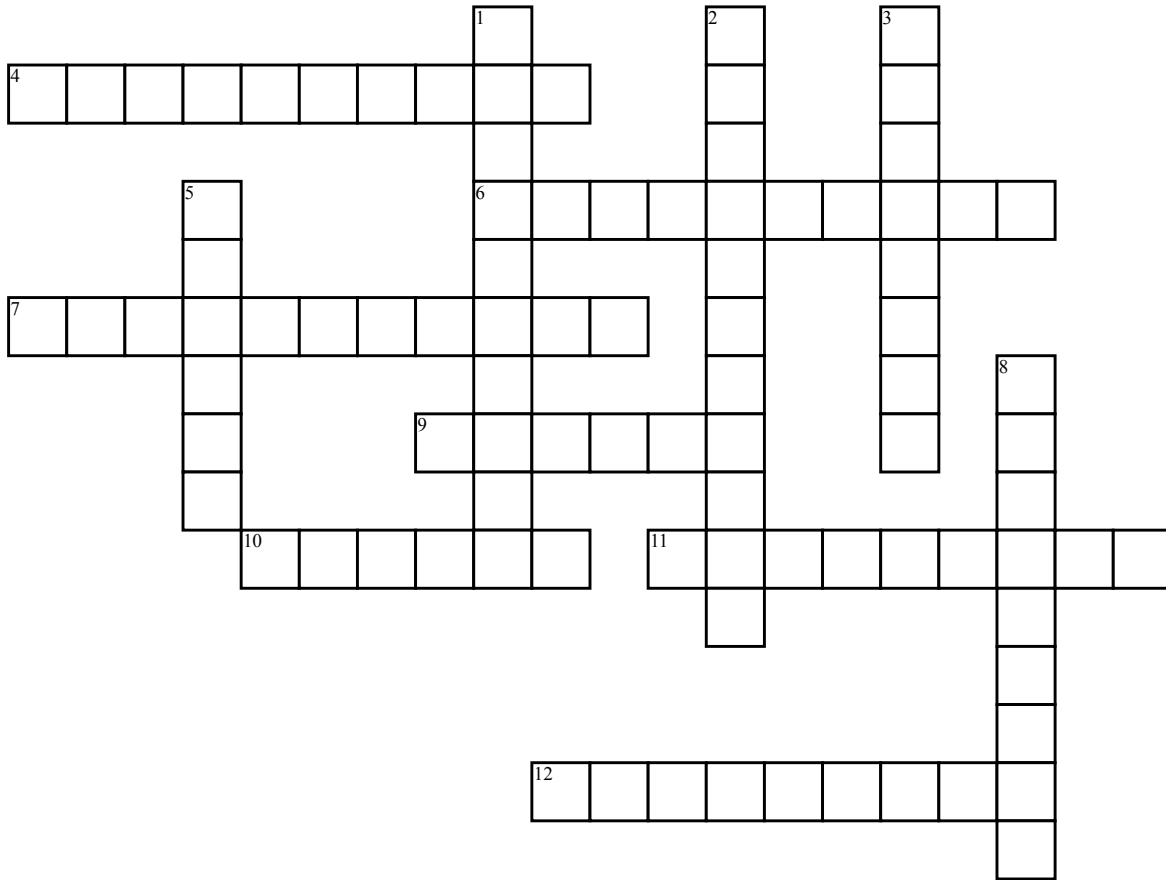


# GRE study puzzle
