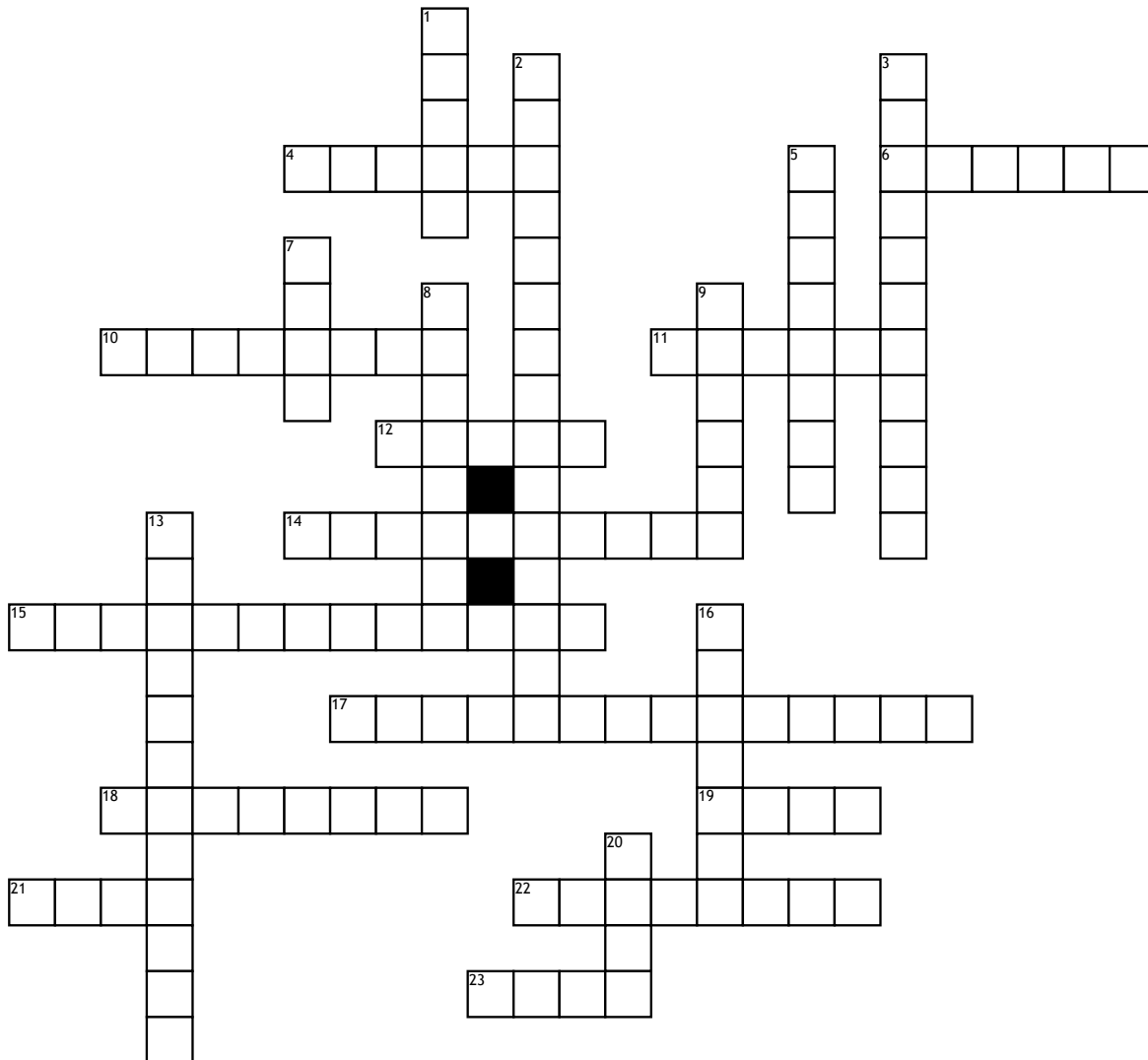


Galvanic Current
