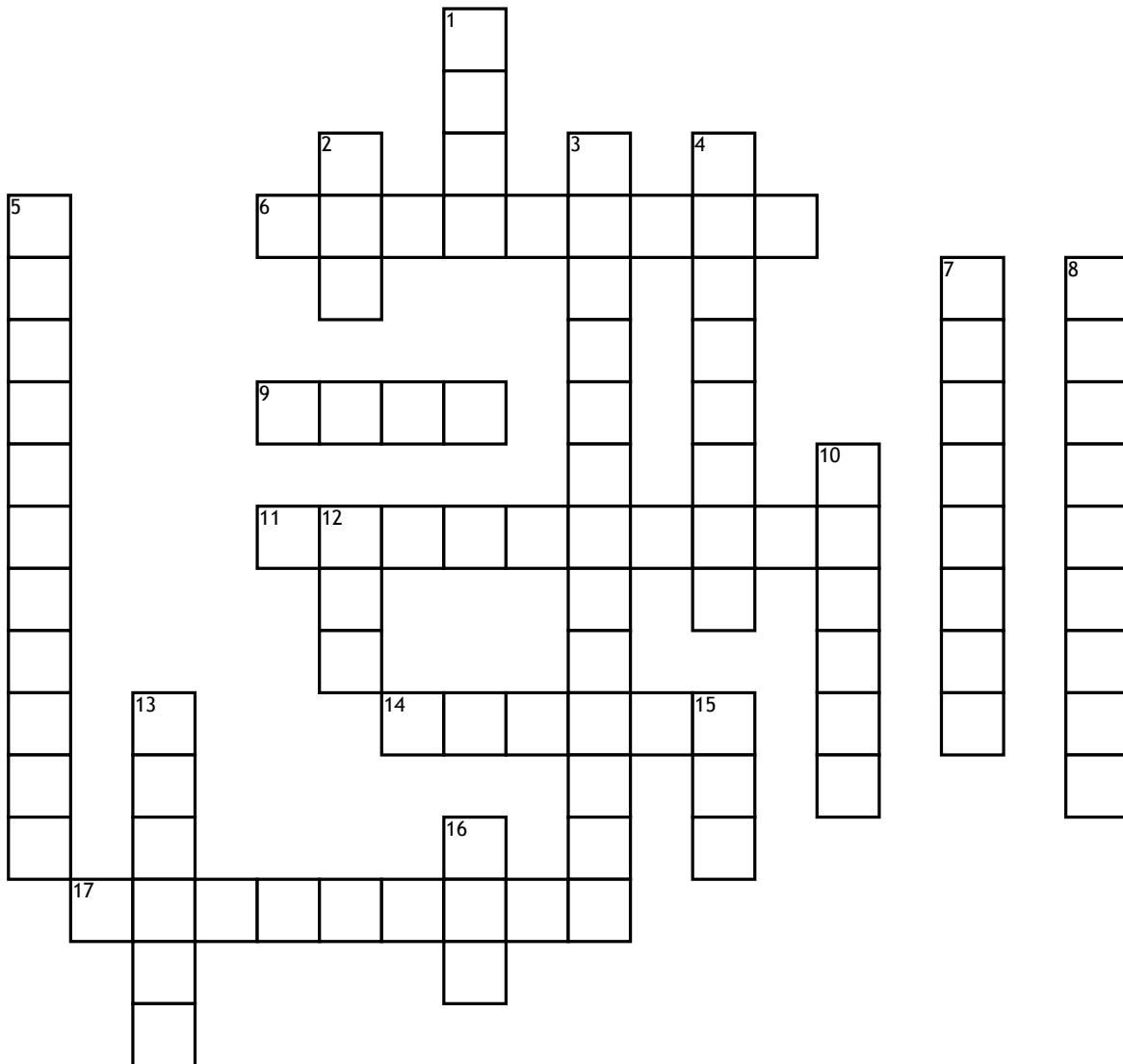


Game & Fur-bearing Animals
