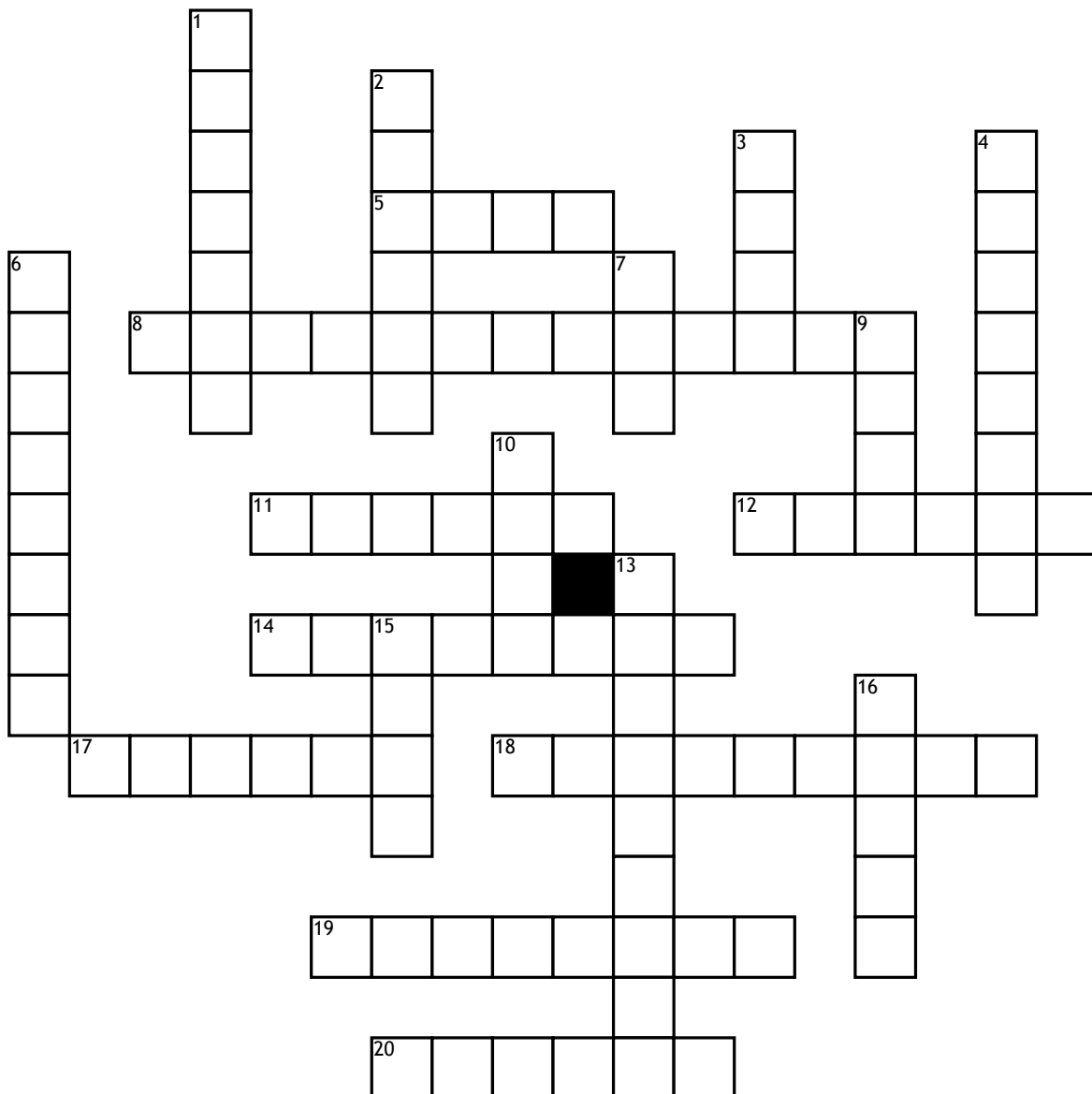

Across

- 5. Another word for cut to remove bulk inside a point before turning over
- 8. This is usually 1.5cm from the edge
- 11. The thread from the ---- is under the machine and connects with the top thread to make a stitch
- 12. Use this seam on sheer fabrics
- 14. You use these to cut fabric
- 17. This cream colour fabric makes your samples

18. You attach this strip to the top edge of trousers or a skirt

19. You'll need wadding to make this textile

20. You do this so the sleeve head fits in the armhole

Down

- 1. Pointy knitting tools
- 2. This pocket hides inside the seam
- 3. A channel zip can be sewn onto this seam
- 4. Do this at the start/end of a seam to prevent the stitch from unravelling

6. This makes your frayed edges neater

7. This number of notches indicate the back sleeve head

9. You snip into a curved seam to get this

10. Use these to attach layers of fabrics before sewing so they do not move

13. Make sure the pattern is laid on fabric the right way round by checking this

15. You use this hot item to attach interlining to fabric

16. Pocket often found on the back of jeans or chest of a shirt
