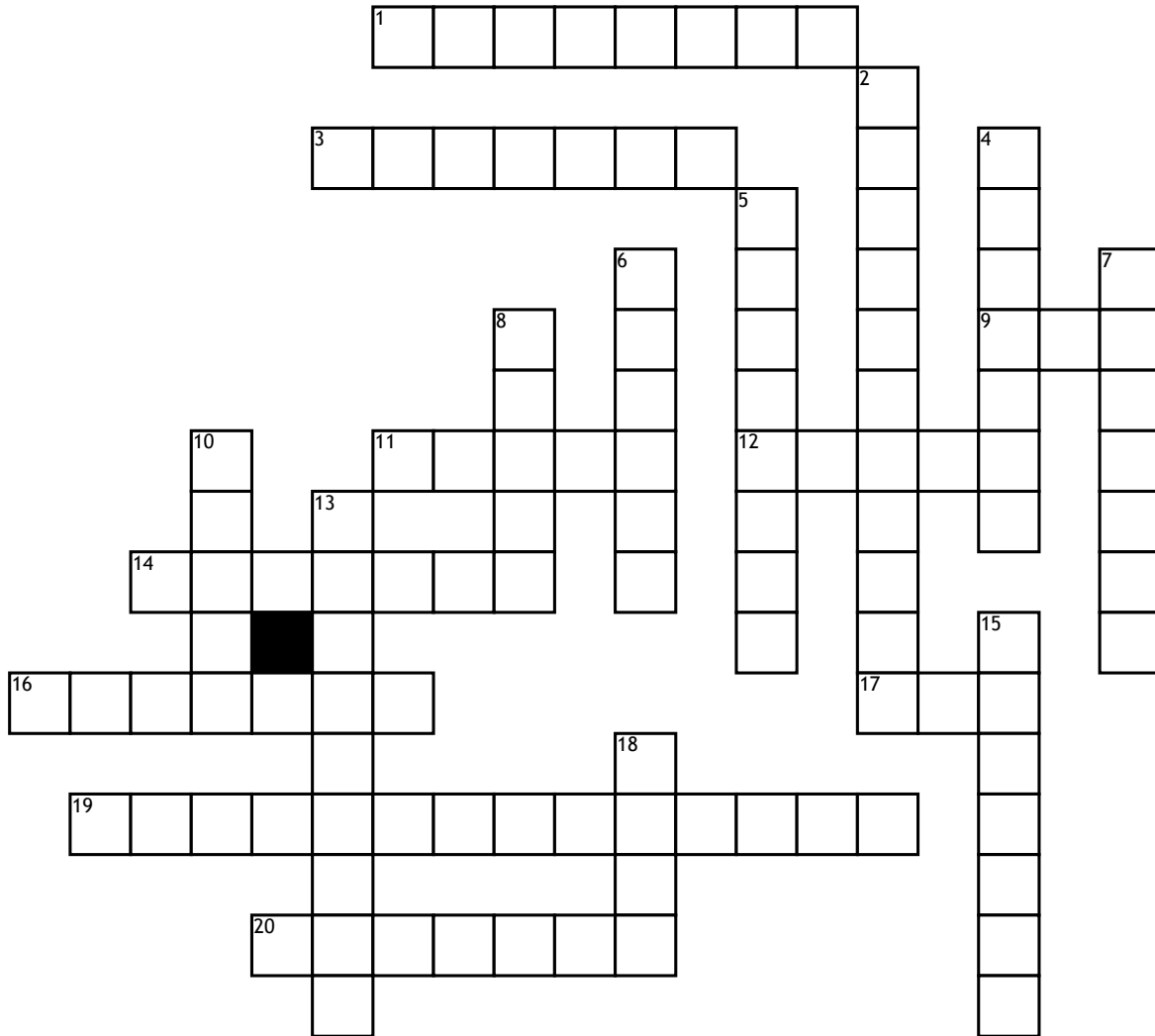


Genius Hour by Dr. Paris
