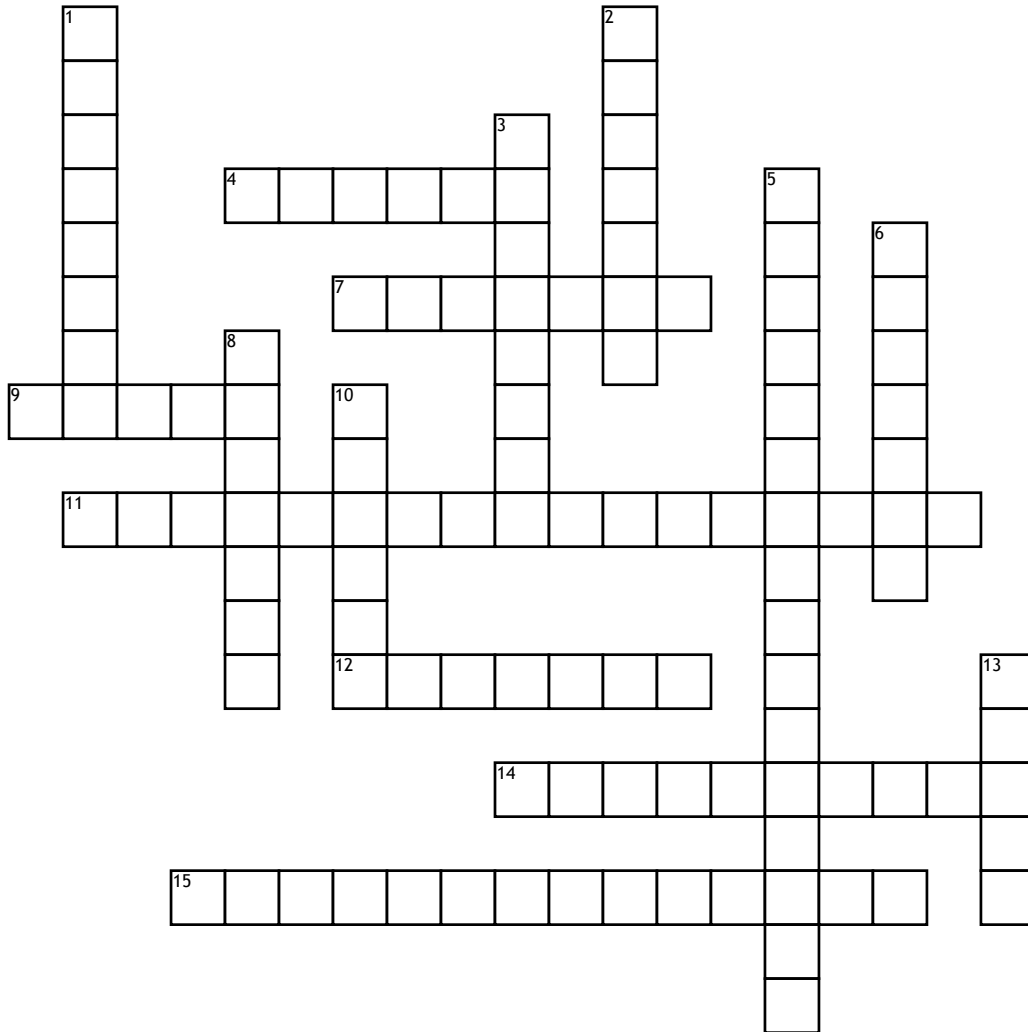

- 7. main setting is Western North America, typically features cowboys, especially in the late 19th and early 20th centuries.
- 9. a type of a play written for theater, television, radio, and film
- 11. is made up but is set in the past and sometimes borrows true characteristics of the time period in which it is set.
- 12. the focus is on a quest that involves bravery and strong values, not a love interest. However, modern definitions also include stories that have a relationship issue as the main focus.

- 14. real life events that have occurred, and not imaginary events.
- 15. typically based on speculative scientific discoveries or developments, environmental changes, space travel, or life on other planets, forms part of the plot or background.

- 1. uses suspense, tension and excitement as the main elements.
- 2. focuses on a puzzling crime, situation, or circumstance that needs to be solved.
- 3. features a world in which everything is imperfect, and everything goes terribly wrong.

- 5. involve things that could have taken place in real life, with the character reacting in the same manner as real people might react.
- 6. events that have not occurred, and are imaginary.
- 8. form of literary genre in which a plot cannot occur in the real world, typically involves magic
- 10. purpose is to create feelings of fear, dread, repulsion, and terror in the audience
- 13. a category of artistic composition, as in music or literature, characterized by similarities in form, style, or subject matter
