 2. The value of the output of goods and services produced in a country in a year including money that leaves and enters the country
 3. A country that is at a relatively early stage in the process of economic development
 4. The portion of the economy concerned with transportation, communications, and utilities, sometimes extended to the provision of all goods and services to people in exchange for payment
 5. Economic policies imposed on less developed countries by international agencies to create conditions encouraging international trade
 6. The gross value of a product minus the costs of raw materials and energy
 7. Provision of small loans and financial services to individuals and small businesses in developing countries
 8. A portion of the economy concerned with the direct extractions of materials from the Earth's surface, generally through agriculture, although sometimes by mining, fishing and forestry
 9. A country that has progressed relatively far along a continuum of development
 10. The portion of the economy concerned with manufacturing useful products through processing, transforming and assembling raw material
