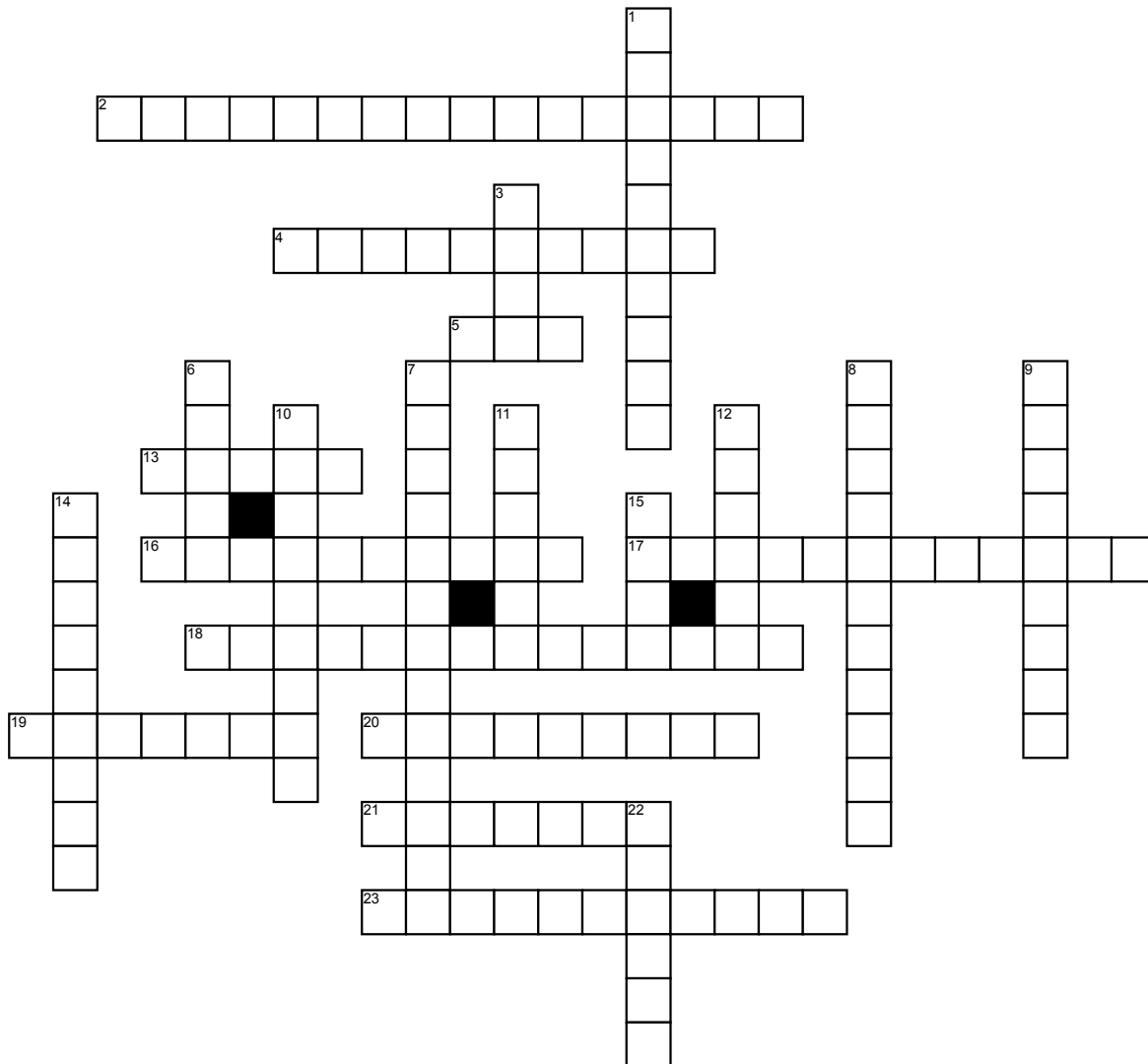


Geography Crossword
