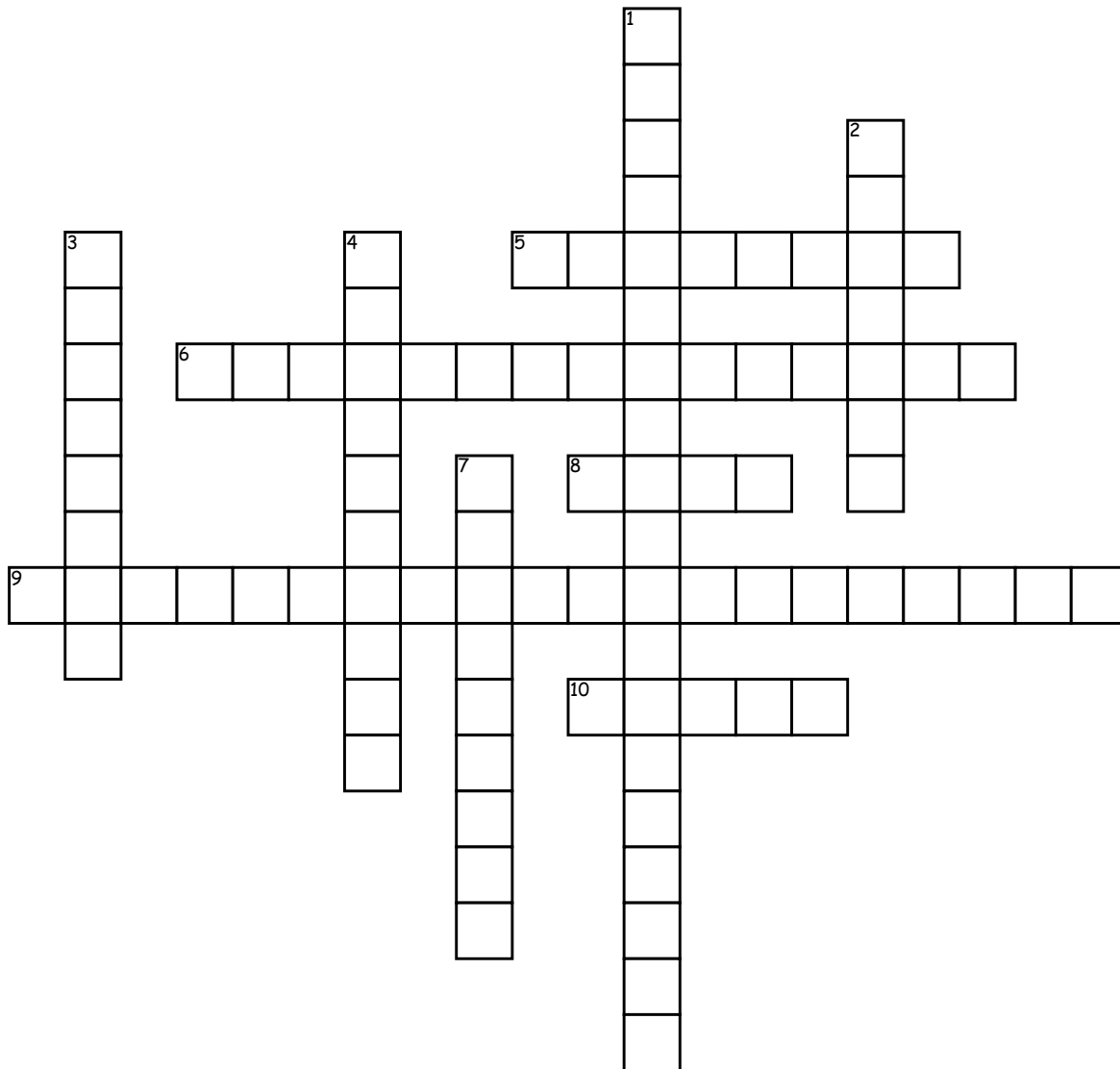


# Geography Glossary
