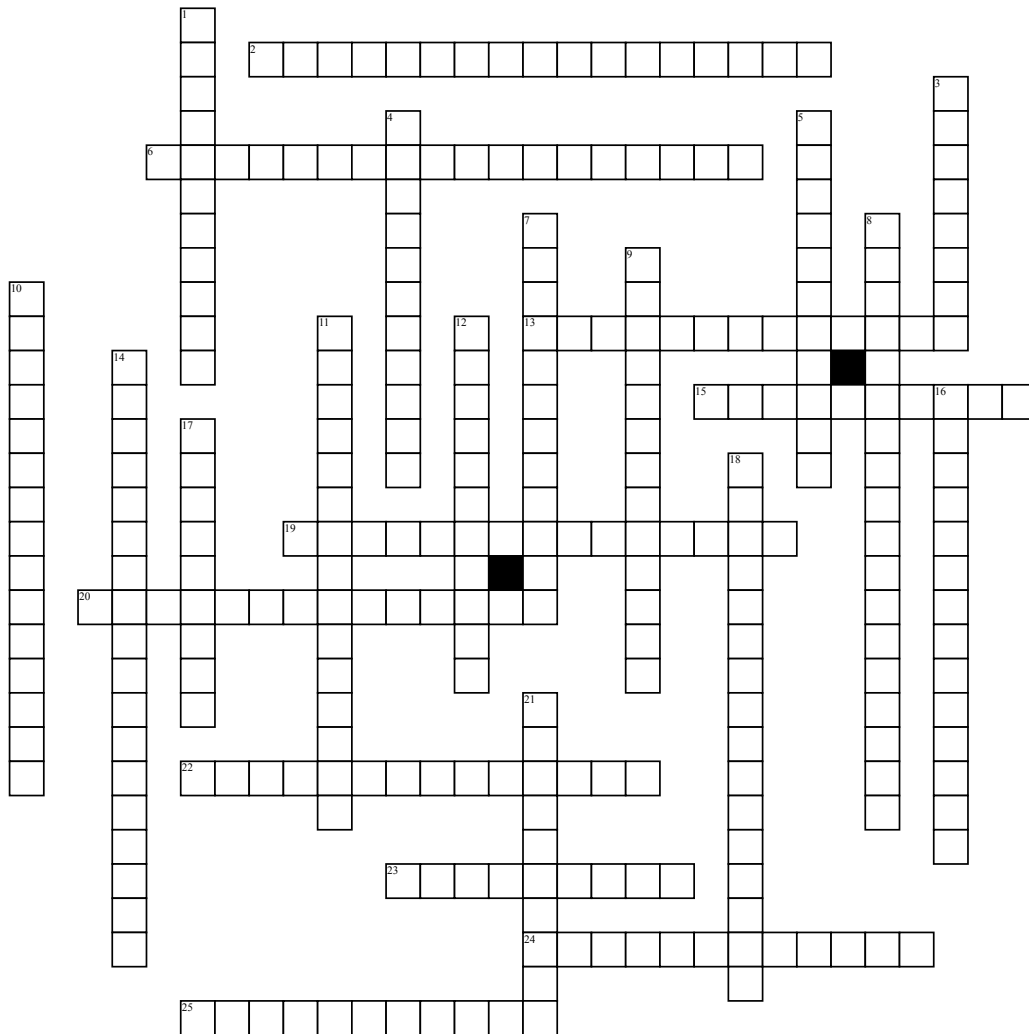


Geography Subfields Crossword Puzzle
