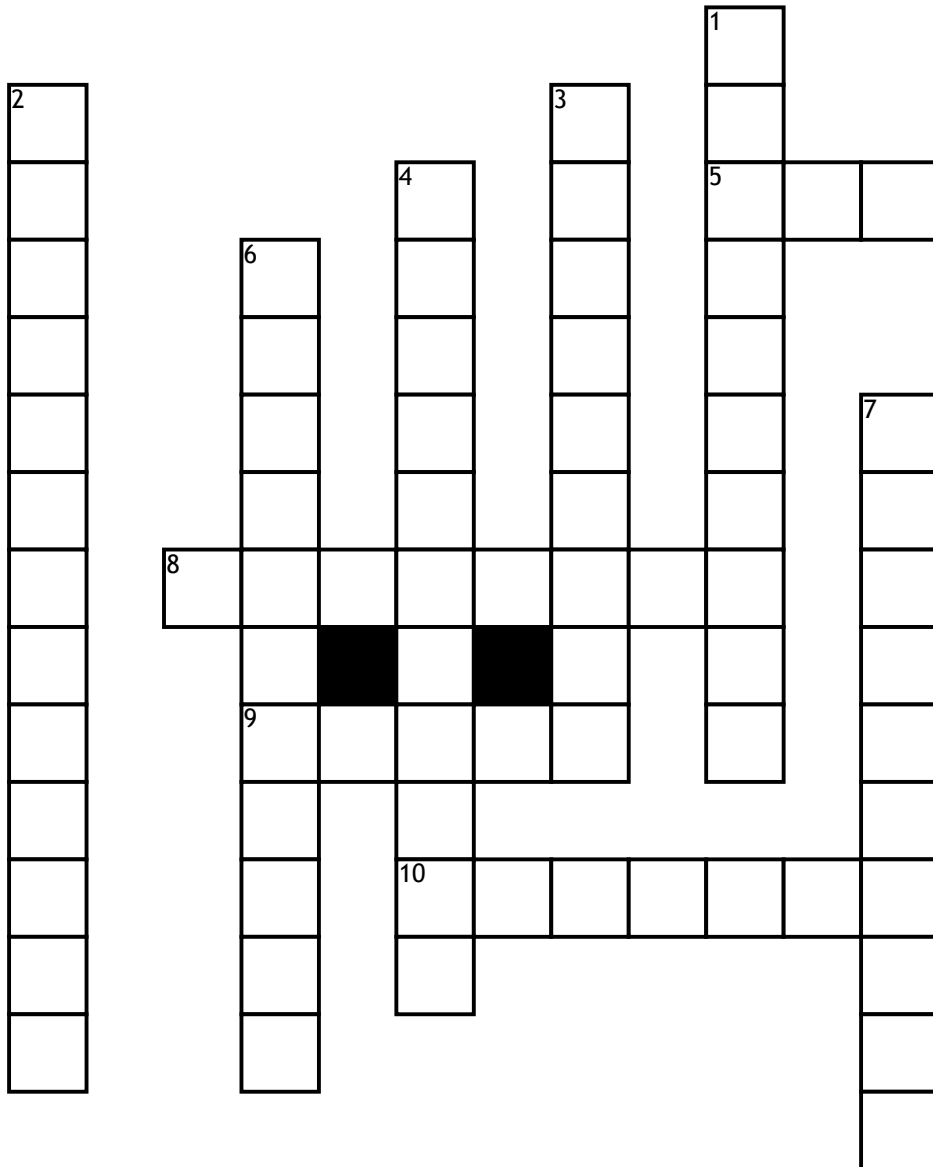

1. half of a spherical or roughly spherical body (such as a planet)

2. the meridian of 0 degrees longitude which runs through the original site of the Royal Observatory at Greenwich, England

3. the arc or portion of the earth's equator intersected between the meridian of a given place and the prime meridian and expressed either in degrees or in time

4. any of a set of numbers used in specifying the location of a point on a line, on a surface, or in space

6. a circle graduated to degrees or quarters and printed on a chart to show direction

7. something that indicates a limit; a separation between two or more areas
