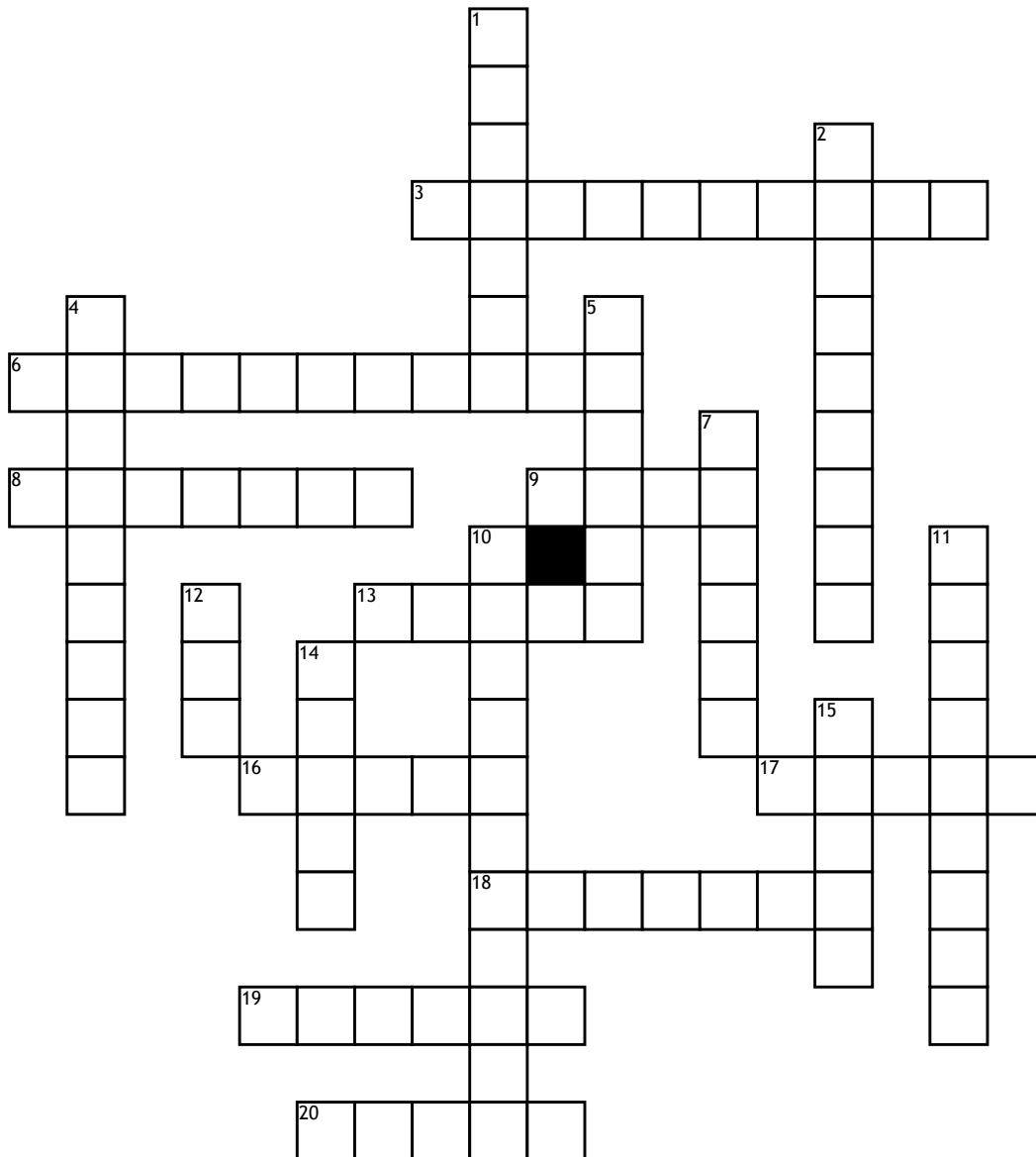

- 16. Triangular area usually found at the mouth of a river.
- 17. Fertile spot in a desert where water is found and some plant life.

- 20. Natural flowing waterway that begins in the mountains and ends in a larger body of water.
