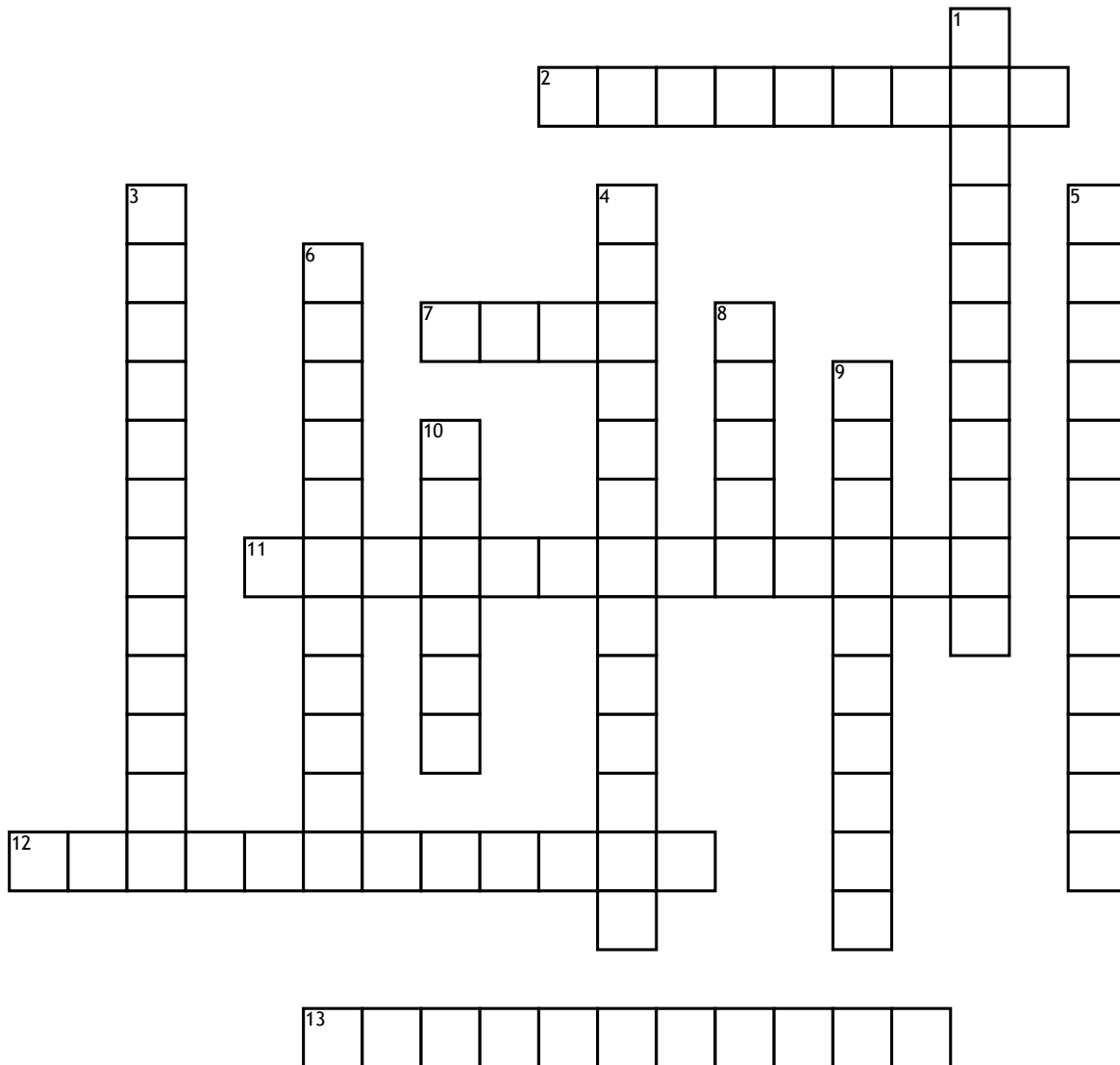


Geography Water Crossword

1. An area of low-lying ground adjacent to a river, formed mainly of river sediments and subject to flooding.
