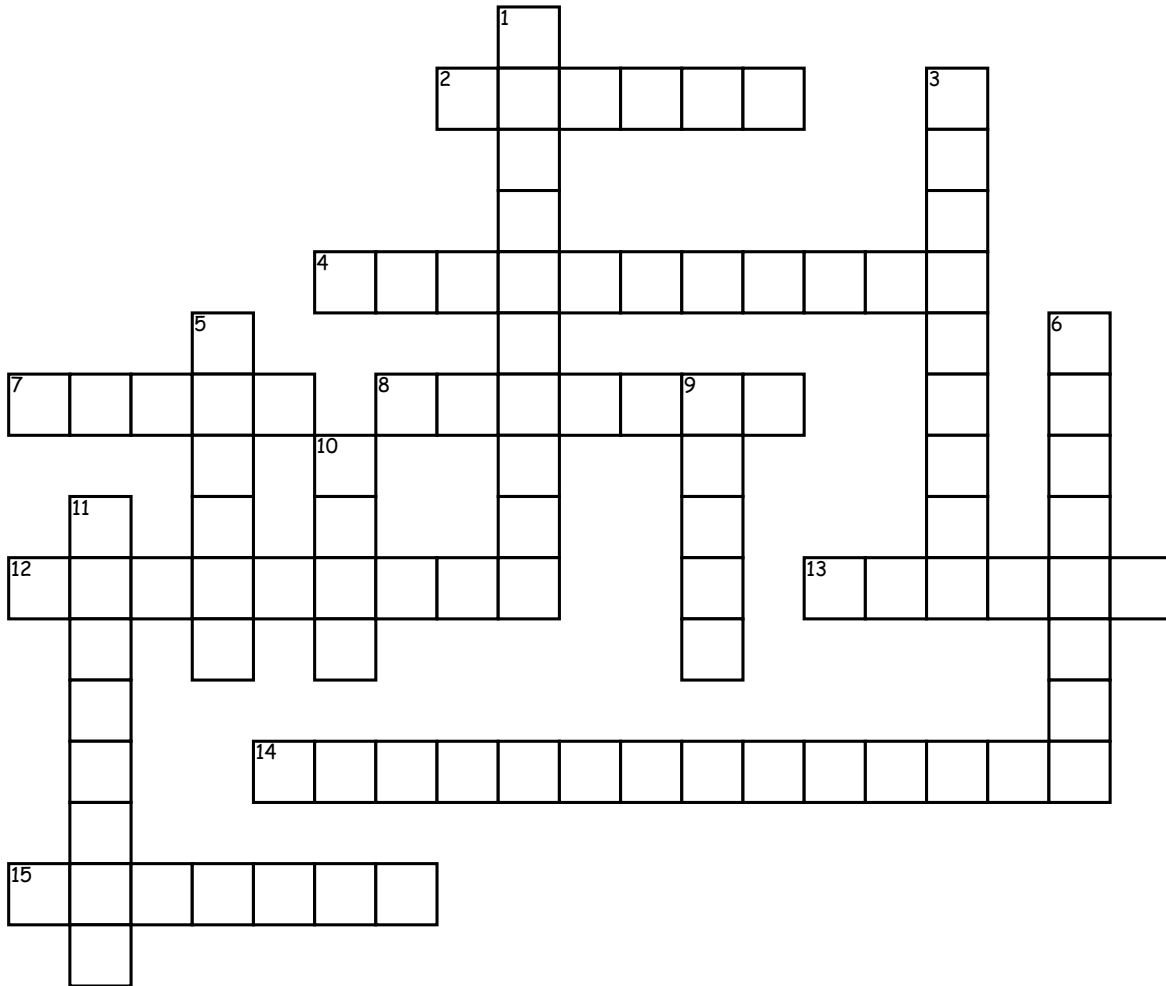


# Geology Crossword
