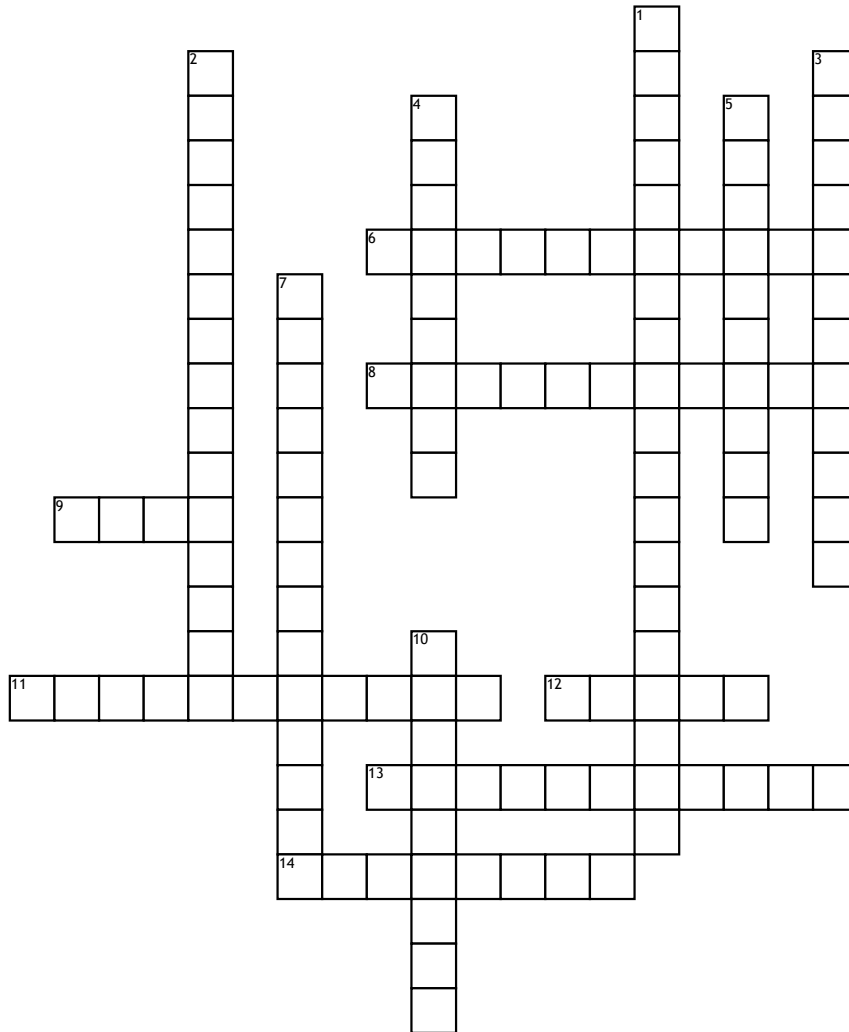


Georgia and World War II

8. Roosevelt had a disease called polio, and visited this Georgia city for polio therapy.

1. Employed nearly 30,000 Georgians as well as produced over 660 B-29 bombers.

2. He was one of the first politicians to argue that the US needed military bases in foreign territories to secure international security.

3. Many of Georgia's ships came to be called this because Roosevelt said they would, "bring liberty to Europe!"

4. This act sent supplies and war materials to U.S. allies in Europe in the fight against Germany.

5. He served on the House Naval Affairs Committee where he won the nickname, "the father of the two-ocean navy."

7. In 1986, this governor established the Georgia Commission on the Holocaust.

10. Nazis rounded up many Jews and forced into concentration camps where millions died.
