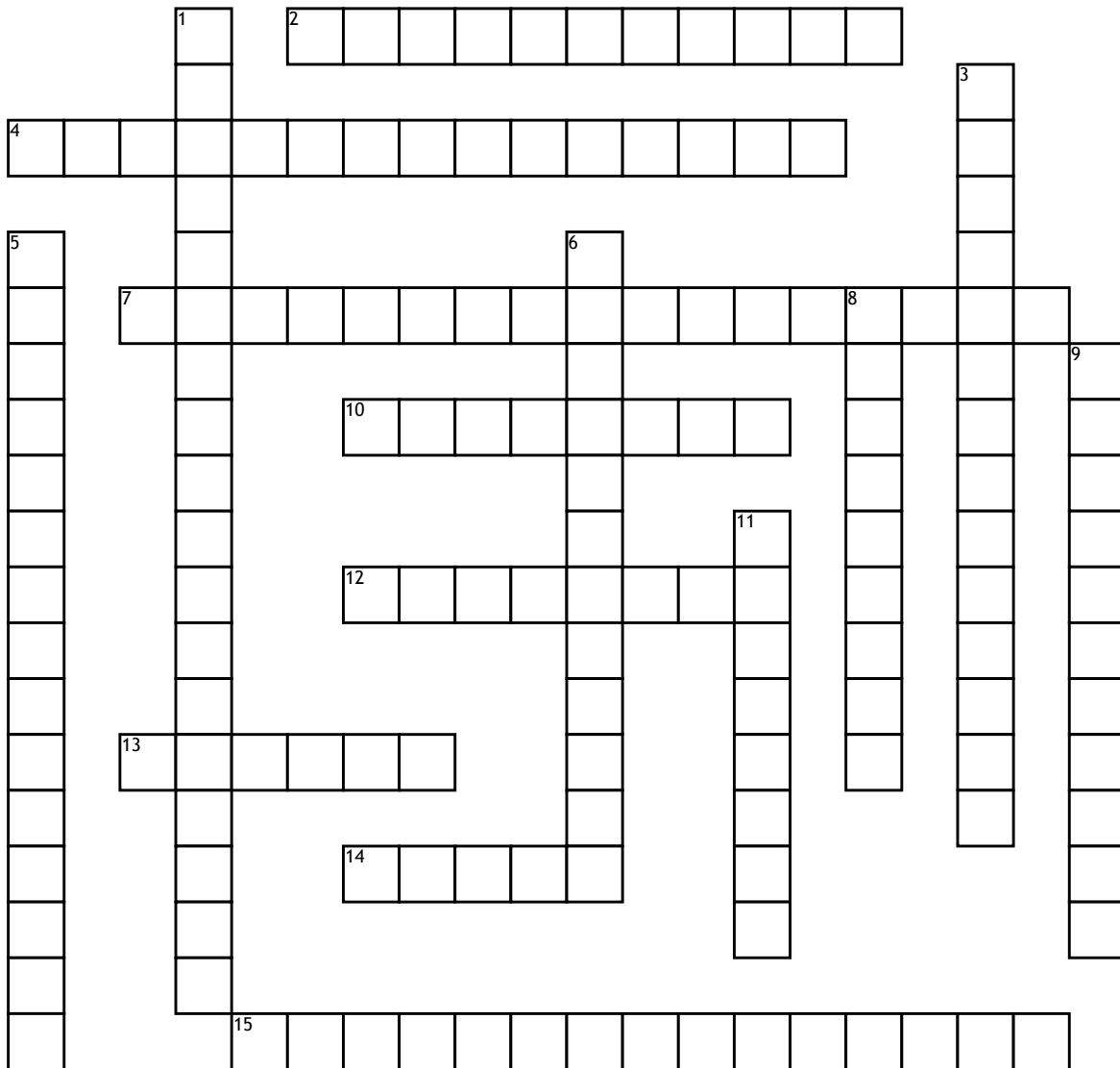


Georgia's Government Crossword Puzzle

13. A crime, involving violence, and punishable by imprisonment for a year or more or by death.

14. Money that people have to pay to the government.

15. The chief law officer who represents the government and serves as its principal legal adviser.

1. An elected official serving as deputy to the governor of a state.

3. The branch in charge of deciding the meaning of laws, how to apply them to real situations, and whether a law breaks the rules of the Constitution.
