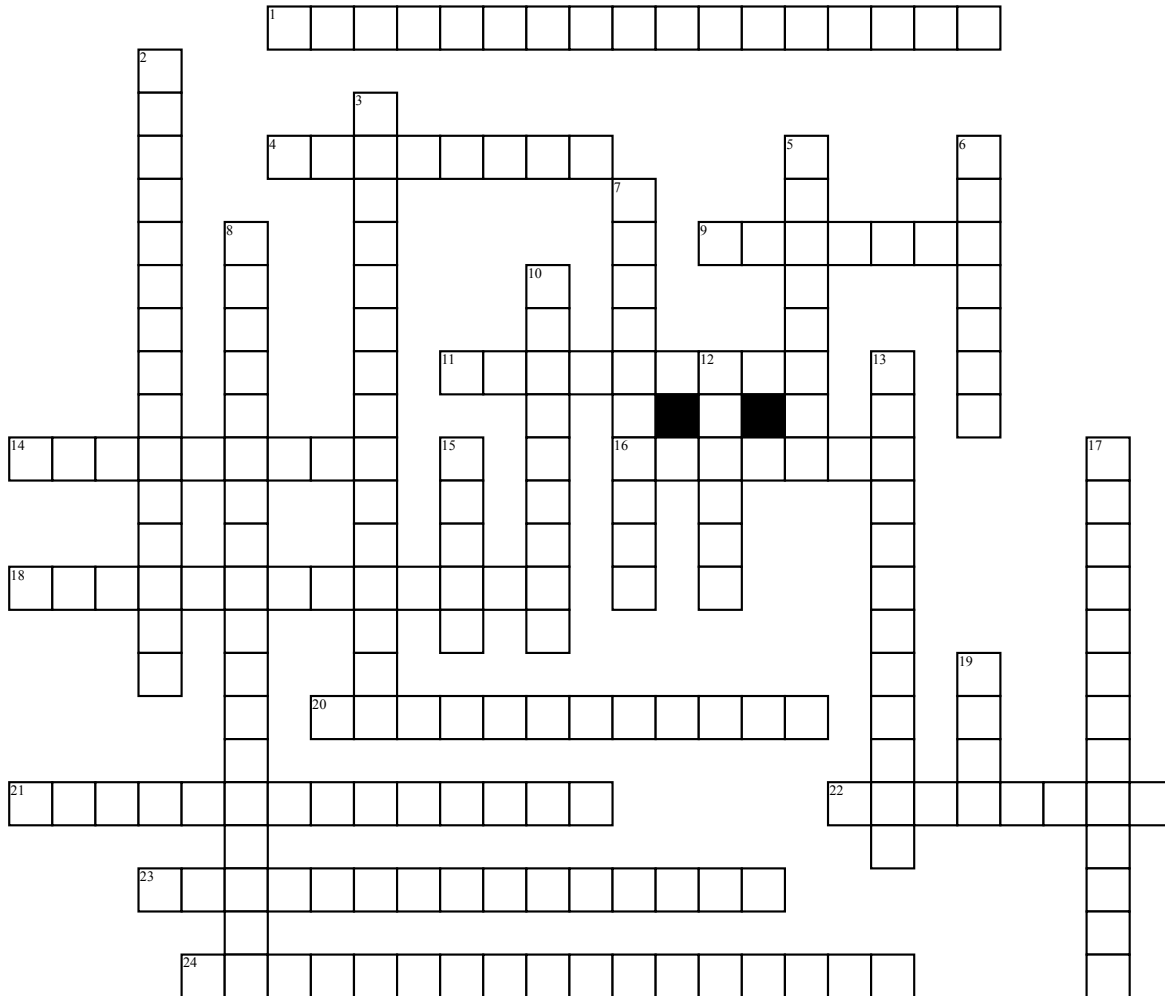


# Georgia's Regions
