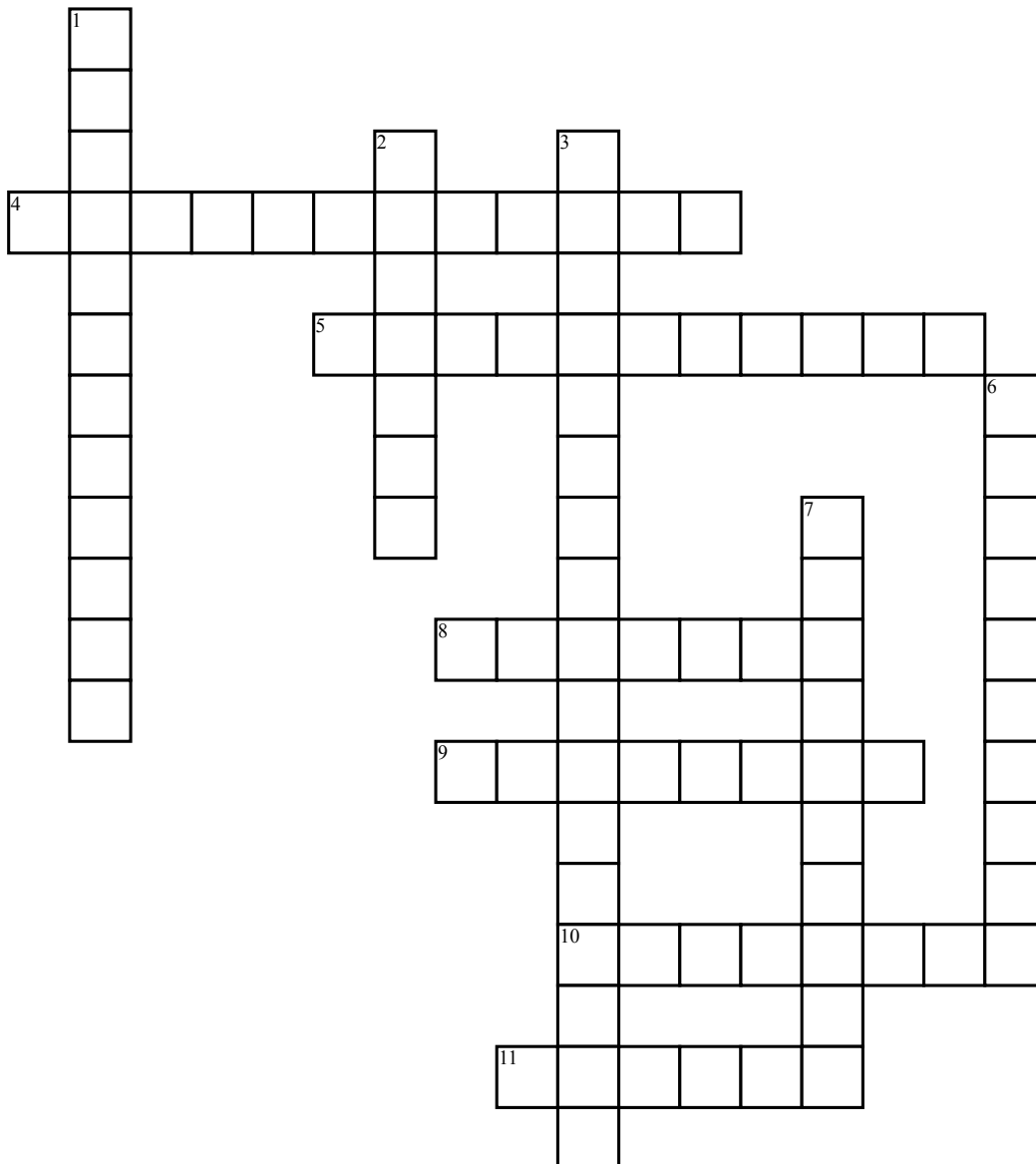

- 5. The Hohenzollern Germany, from the unification of Germany following the Franco-Prussian War 1870 - 1871 and crowning of Wilhelm I as German Emperor at the Palace of Versailles
- 8. was a historic state originating out of the Duchy of Prussia and the Margraviate of Brandenburg
- 9. Prussian statesman who dominated German and European affairs from the 1860s until 1890.
- 10. French military and political leader who rose to prominence during the French Revolution and led several successful campaigns during the French Revolutionary Wars

- 11. Was the last German Emperor

- 1. is politics or diplomacy based primarily on considerations of given circumstances and factors, rather than explicit ideological notions or moral and ethical premises.

- 3. A conflict between the Second French Empire of Napoleon III and the German states of the North German Confederation led by the Kingdom of Prussia
