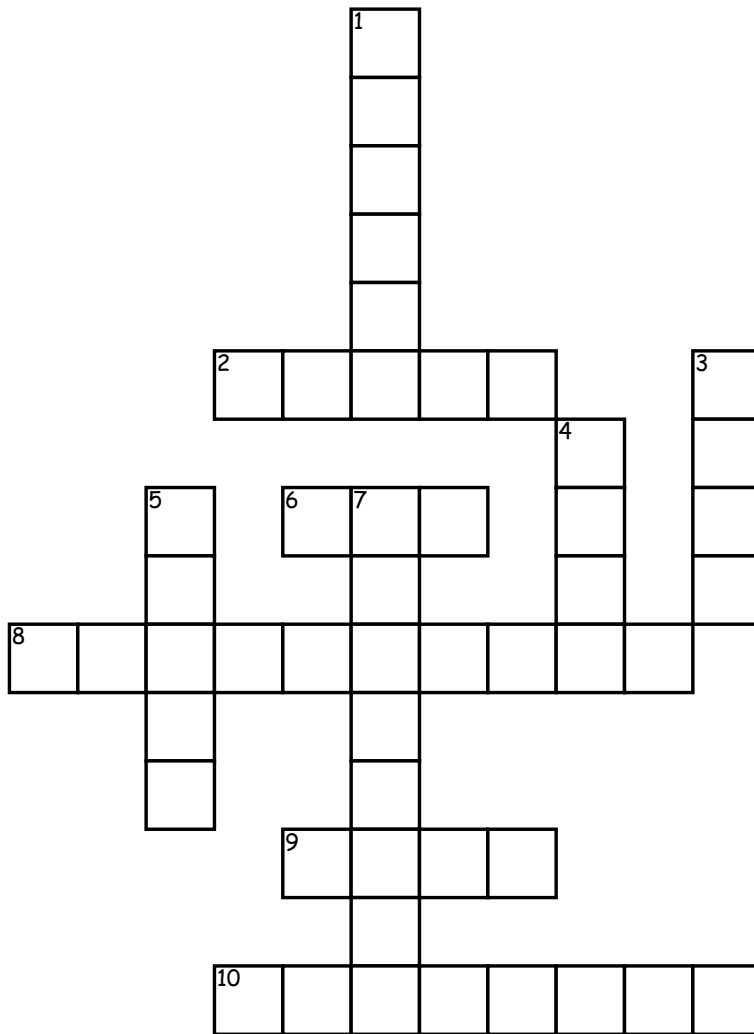

1. The force that moves a plane through the air
3. To tilt the airplane inward while making a turn

5. Moveable sections, hinged on the rear of the wing, that can be lowered to increase lift and drag during takeoff or landing
7. Moveable sections, hinged on the rear edge of the wing near the wingtip, that cause the airplane to roll
