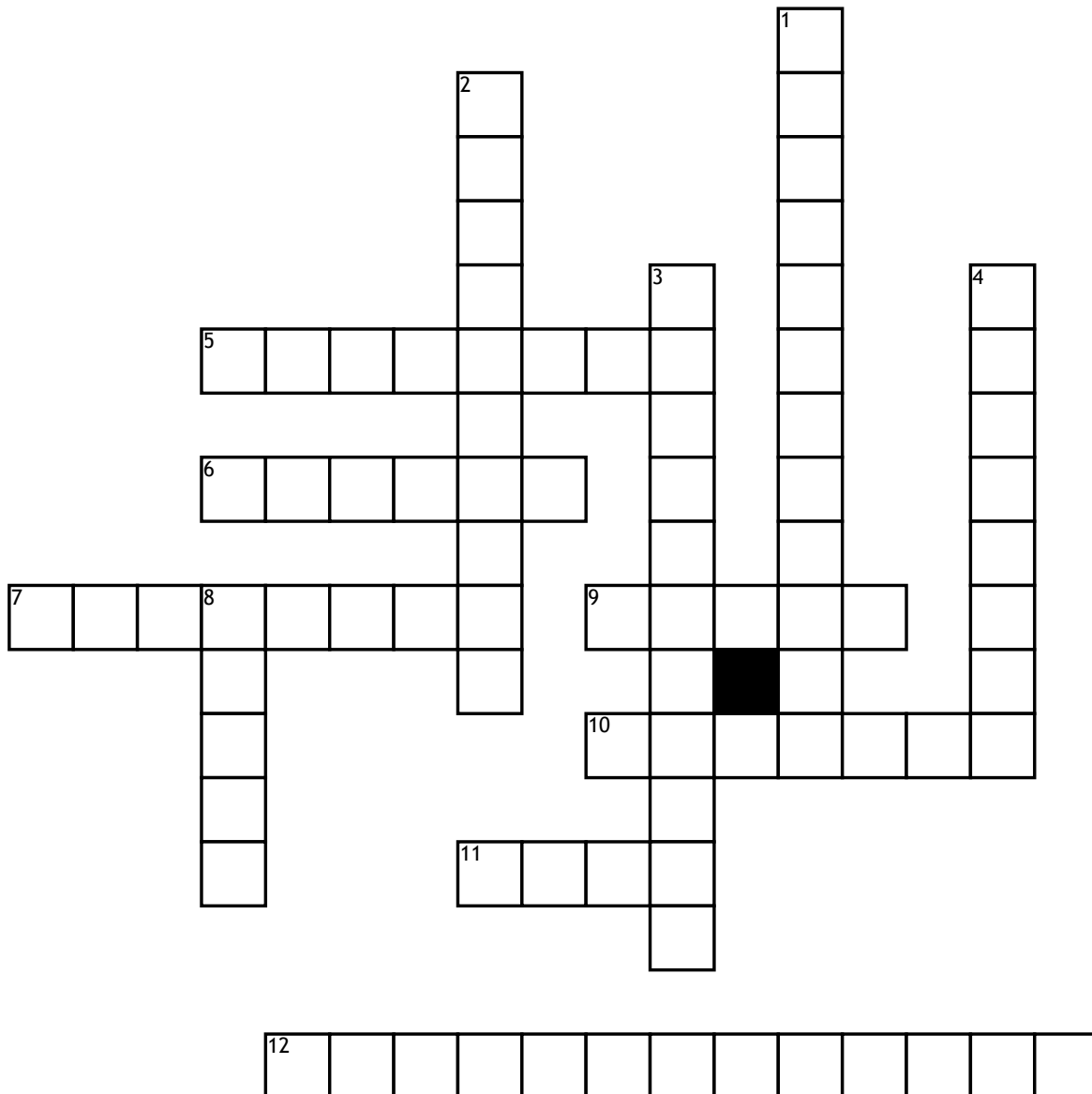


# Glaciation

**5.** A very deep crack in the thick ice of a glacier.

**6.** A round hollow made in the side of a mountain by the action of a glacier

**7.** The process of rubbing away the surface of something.

**9.** Small loose stones that form or cover a slope on a mountain.

**10.** A small hill formed by a glacier usually with a stretched, oval shape and found in groups.

**11.** A small mountain lake.

**12.** A deep linear feature, carved into bedrock by glacial erosion.

## Down

**1.** A stream that appears to be too small to have eroded the valley in which it flows.

**2.** A long, thin line, mark, or strip of colour.

**3.** A deep crack near or at the top of a glacier, separating moving ice from ice that is not moving

**4.** The loss of ice or snow from a glacier or iceberg.

**8.** A sharp mountain ridge.
