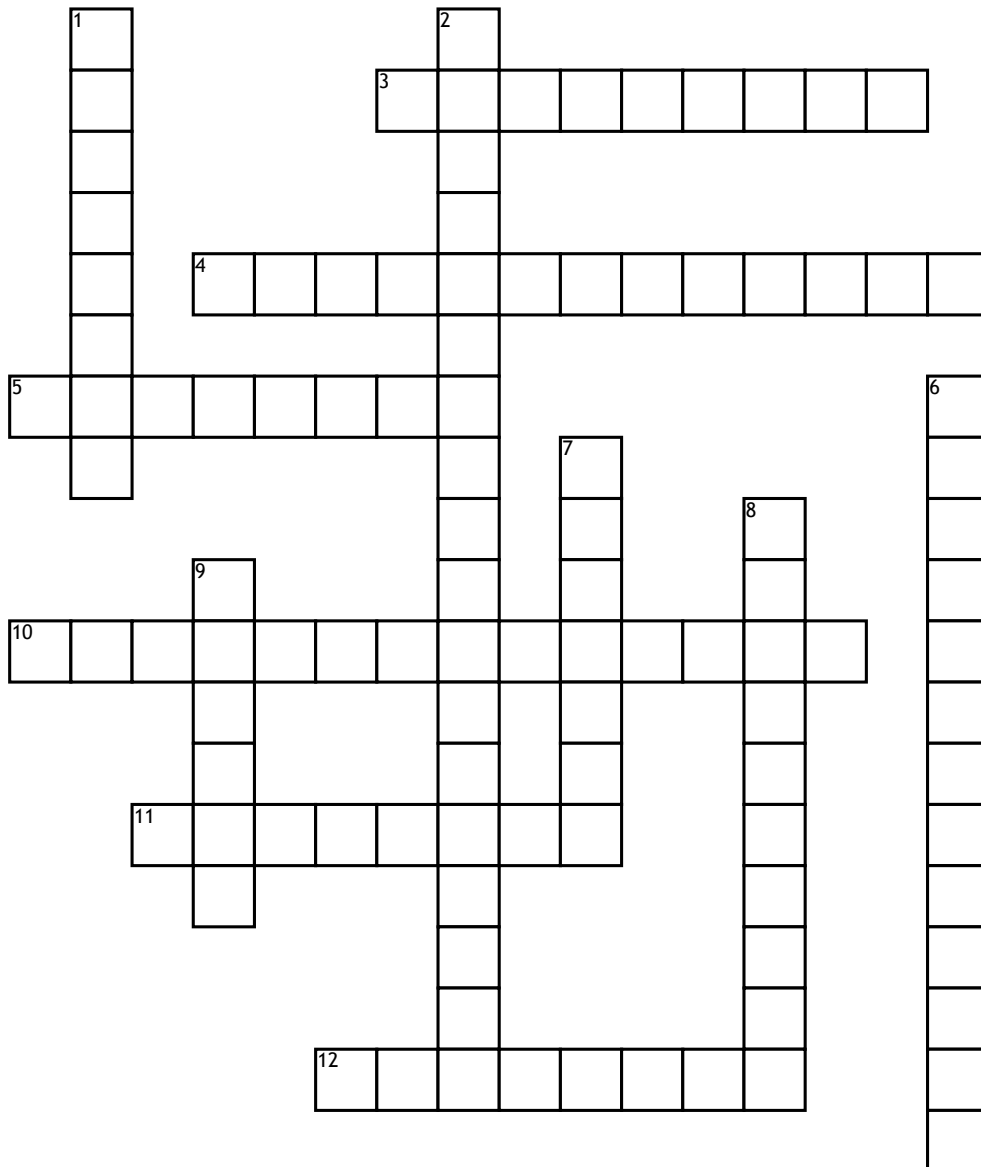


# Glaciers
