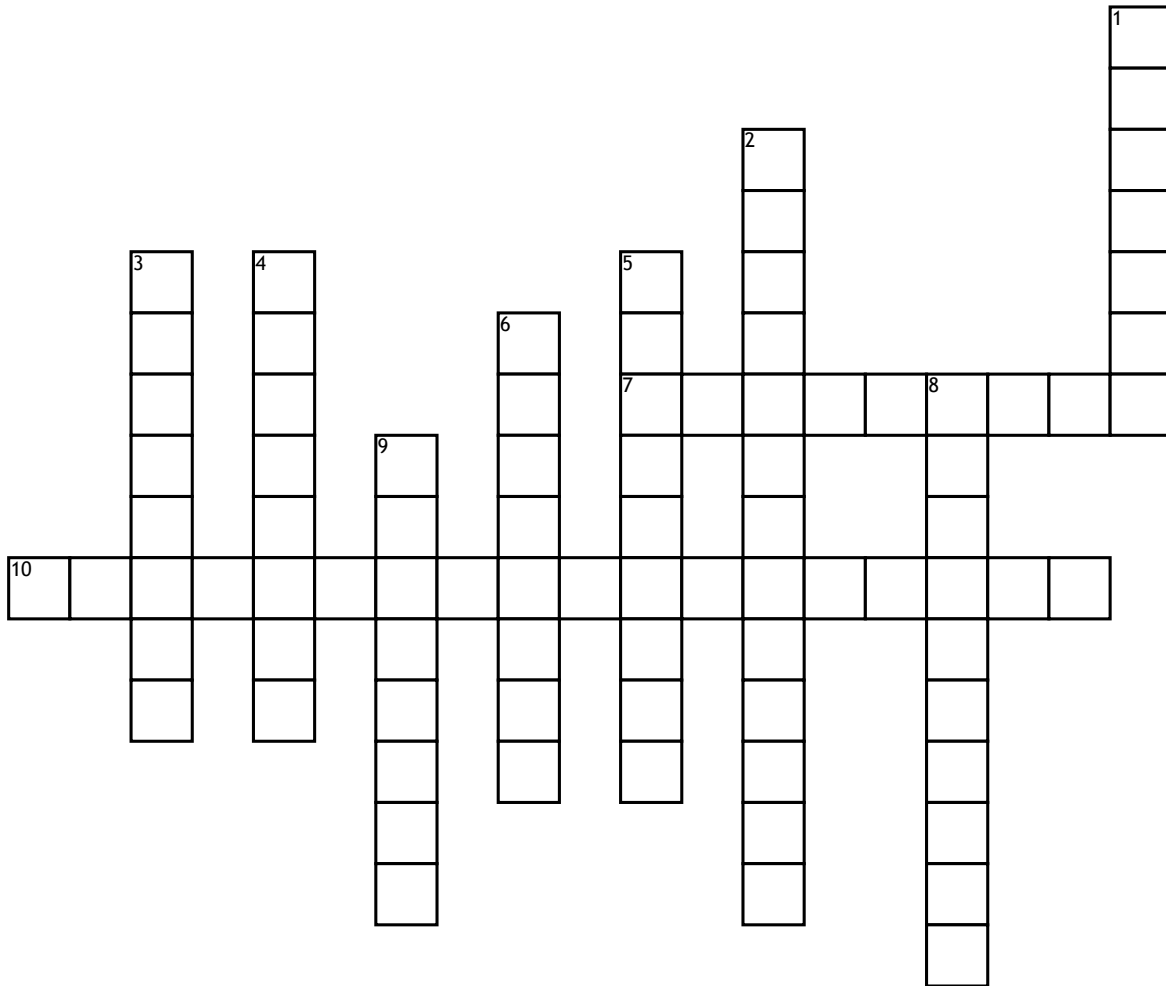


Glaciers



Across

- 7. when a valley glacier comes to a steep slope, great fissures, or cracks
- 10. moving mass of ice, far larger than a valley glacier

Down

- 1. small ice sheets
- 2. long, slow-moving, wedge-shaped stream of ice
- 3. large amounts of rock material build up in several areas of a moving glacier and are deposited

- 4. the lowest level that permanent snows reach in summer
- 5. a mixture of fine sand and silt formed by the crushing of rock under a glacier
- 6. farther inland great mountain peaks
- 8. coarse sand, pebbles, and sharp boulders leave long parallel scratches
- 9. the end of a glacier
