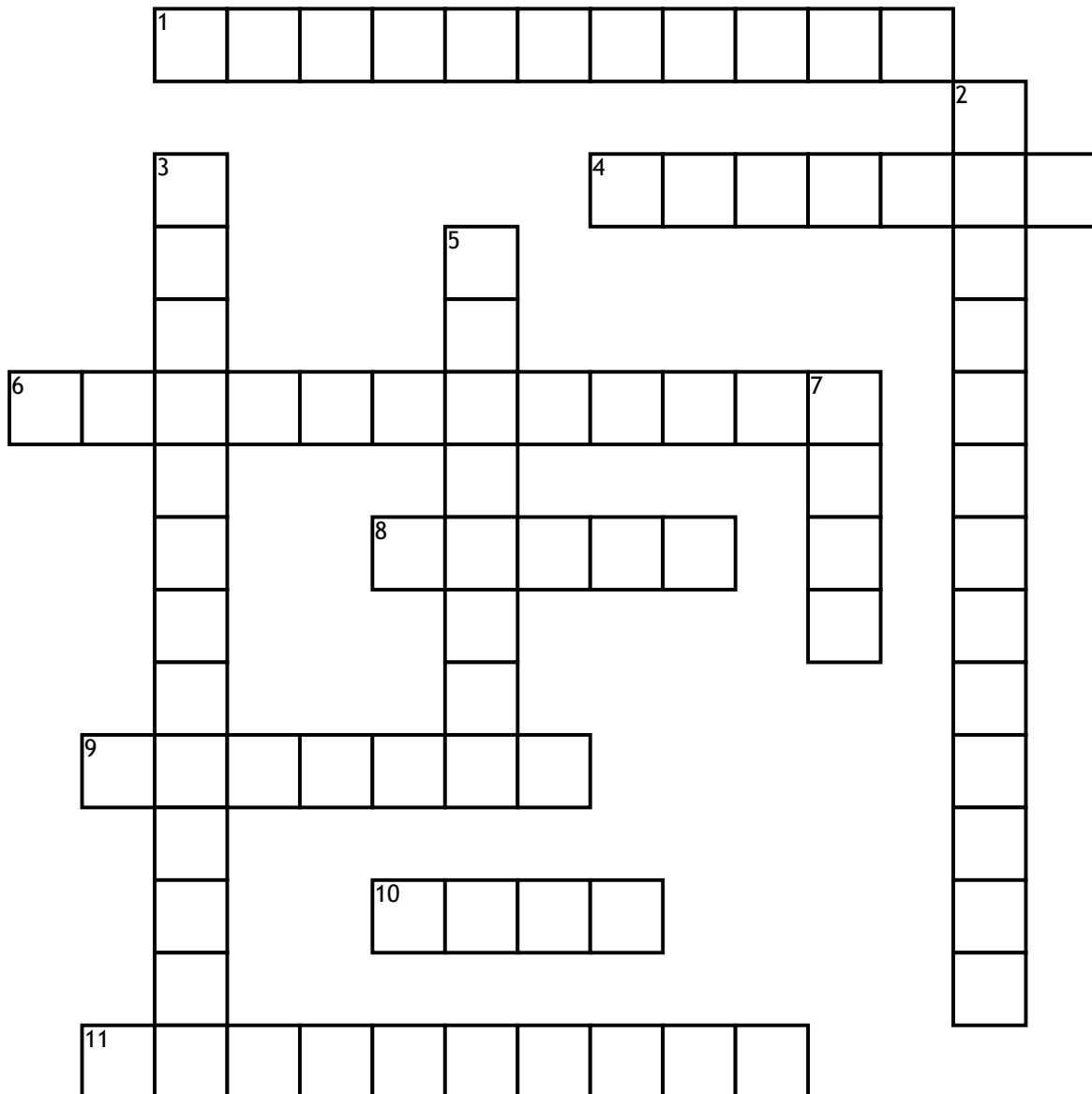


Glaciers
