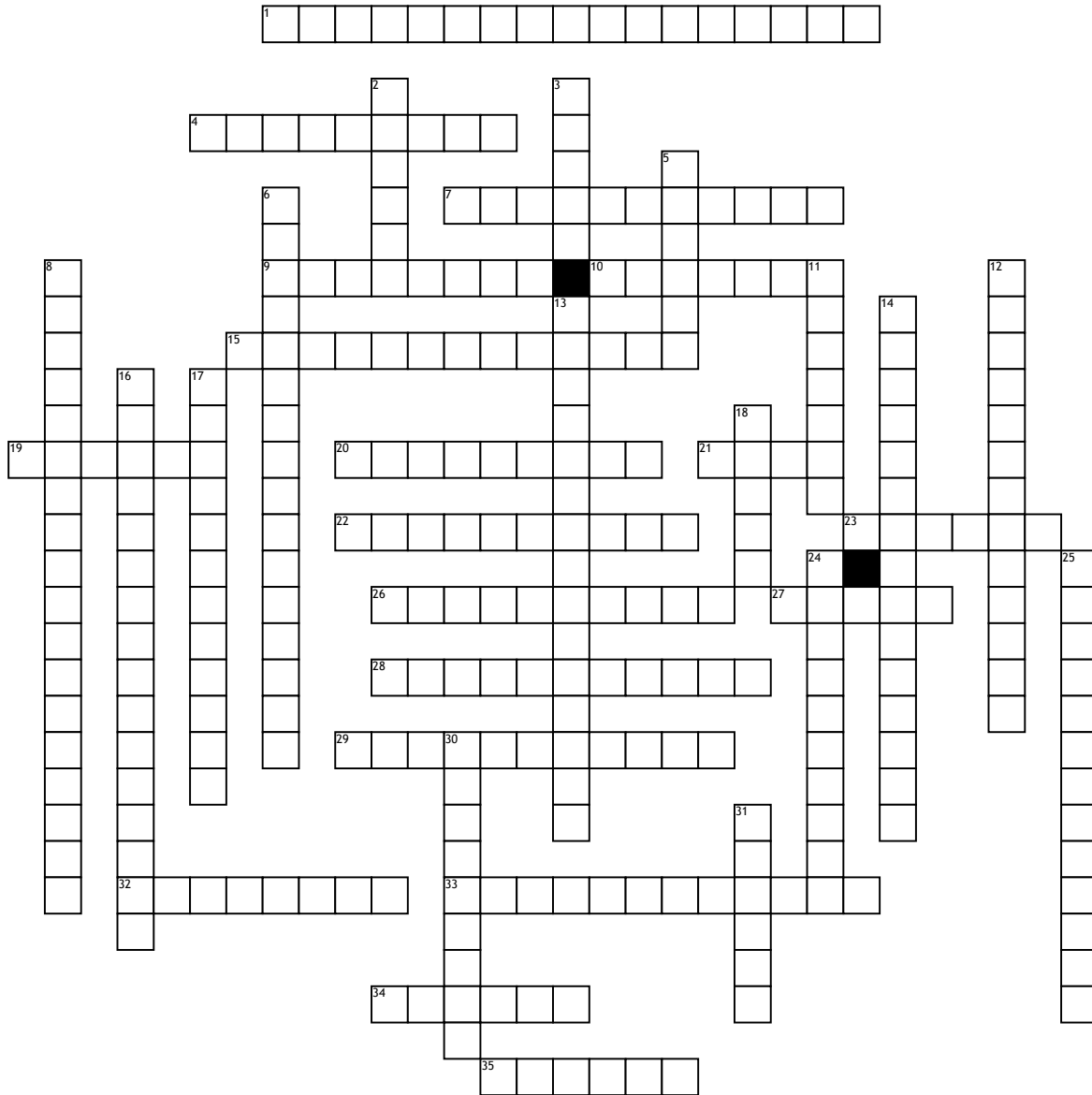

- 1. Portion of the course designated by the Committee that may include piles of material awaiting removal by a greenkeeper.
- 4. Group of people in charge of the competition and/or the course.
- 7. Ground on which play is prohibited.
- 9. Person appointed to assist a referee to decide questions of fact and to report to him any breach of a Rule.
- 10. Player associated with another player on the same side.
- 15. Stroke added to the score of a player as deemed under certain Rules.
- 19. One who carries or handles a players clubs during play.
- 20. Movable straight indicator with or without bunting or other material attached, centered in the hole to show position.
- 21. The standard required for this is 4.5 inches in diameter and 4 inches deep.
- 22. A player in stroke play.

- 23. Person appointed to record a competitors score in stroke play.
 - 26. The status of a ball as soon as the player has made a stroke on the teeing ground.
 - 27. A ball leaves its original position and comes to rest in another place.
 - 28. Temporary accumulation of water on the course which is visible before and after the player takes his stance and is not a water hazard
 - 29. Body of water defined by yellow lines or stakes.
 - 32. A ball not found or identified.
 - 33. All ground of the hole being played which is specially prepared for putting.
 - 34. Area from which turf or soil has been removed and replaced with sand.
 - 35. Any bunker or water.

- 2. Position of a players feet as they prepare to make a stroke.
 - 3. The player entitled to play first from the teeing ground.
 - 5. The area within which play is permitted.

- 6. Natural objects such as stones, twigs, branches, etc.
- 8. Water hazard that you cant drop a ball behind.
- 11. Person appointed to accompany players to decide questions of fact and apply the Rules of Golf.
- 12. A ball is stopped or deflected by an outside agency.
- 13. Ball played when you lose your original ball out of bounds or in a water hazard.
- 14. Playing the holes of the course in their correct sequence.
- 16. When the player has taken his stance and grounded his club except in a hazard.
- 17. Starting place for a hole.
- 18. When the ball is at the bottom of the hole.
- 24. Individual who indicates to player the position of balls during play.
- 25. Any agency not part of the match.
- 30. Anything used, worn or carried for the player except any ball he has played at the hole and any small object used to mark the position of a ball..
- 31. Forward movement of the club.
