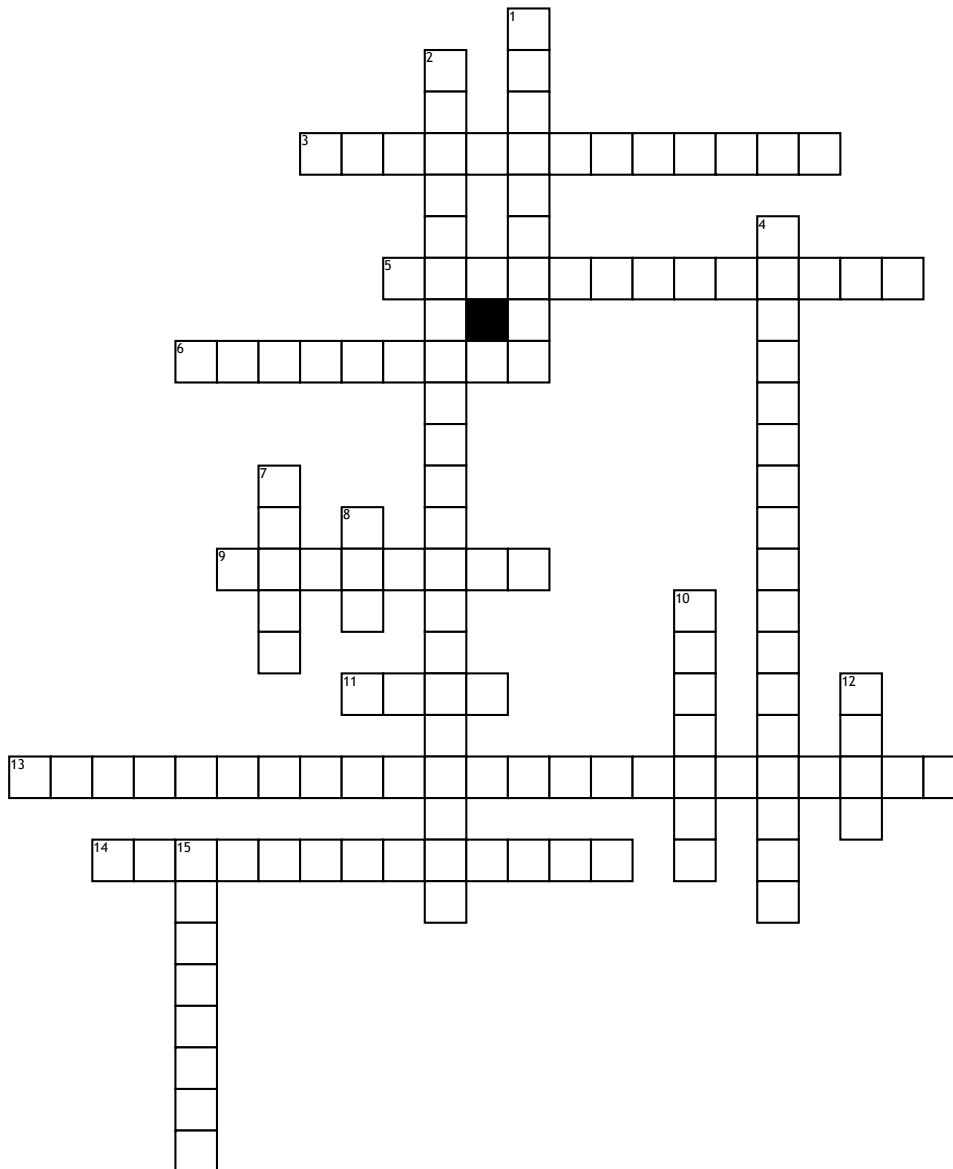

1. Political contributions given to a party candidate or interest group that are limited in amount and fully disclosed-legal

2. Communication containing express words of advocacy of election or defeats: "vote for", "defeat"

8. Commission created by the 1974 amendments got the federal election campaign act to administer election reform laws
