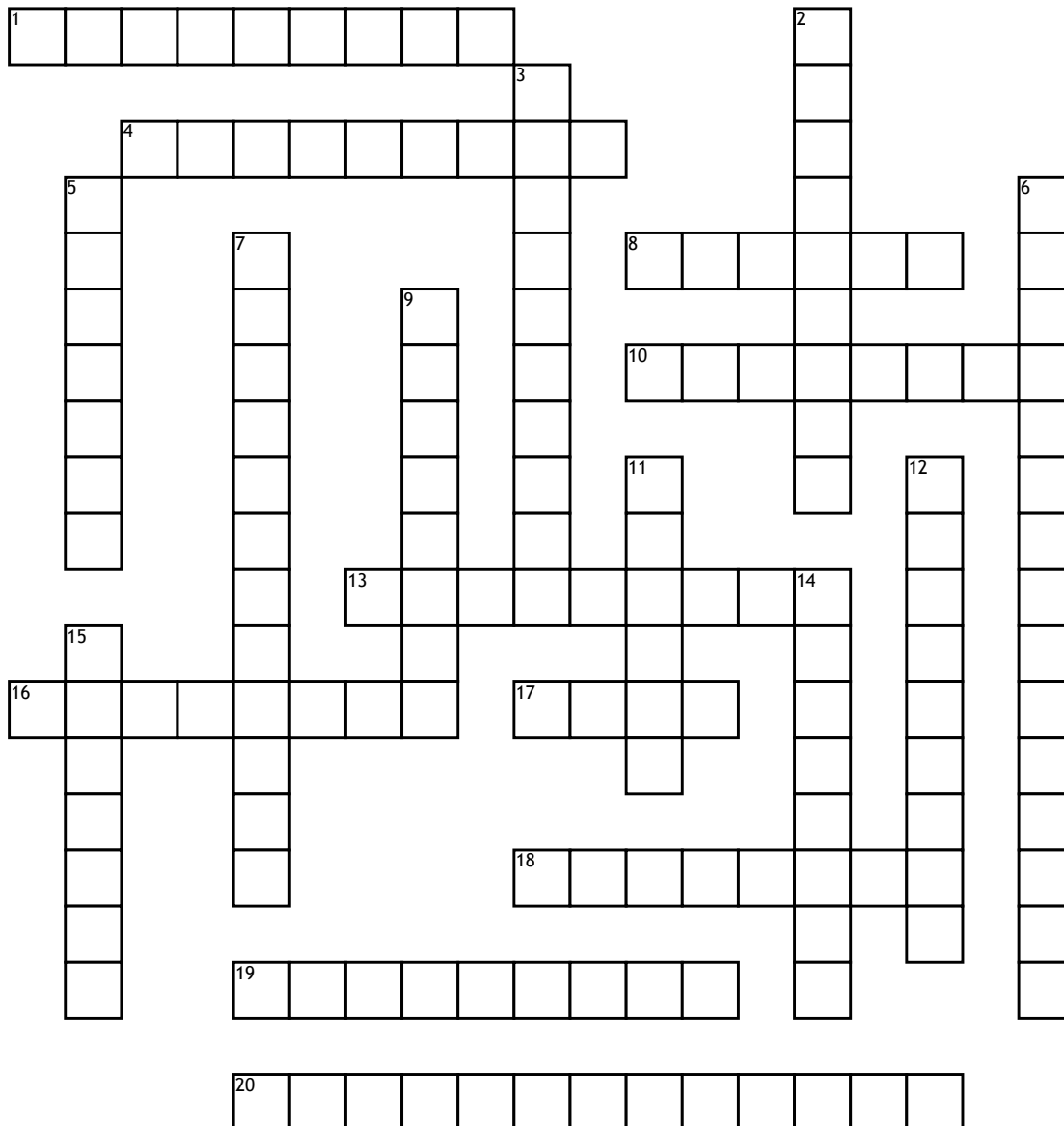


Government Crossword
