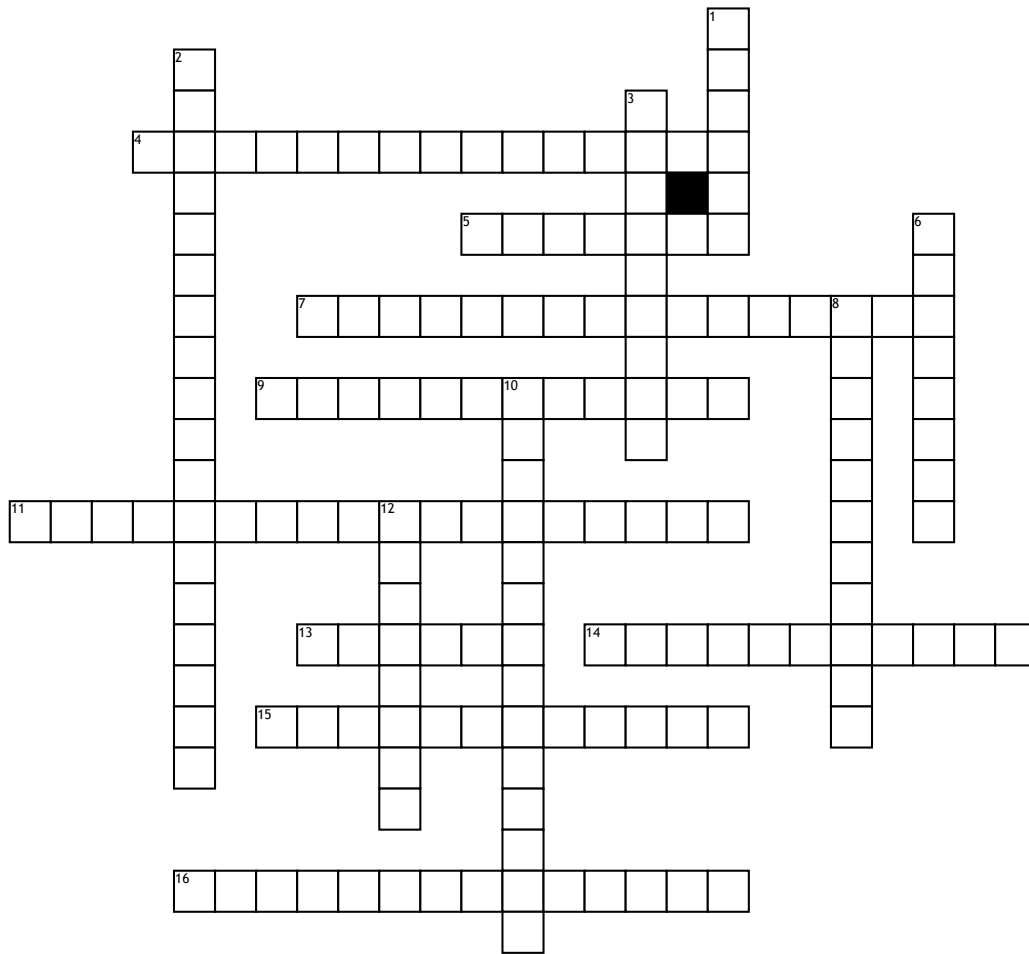


Government Crossword Puzzle
