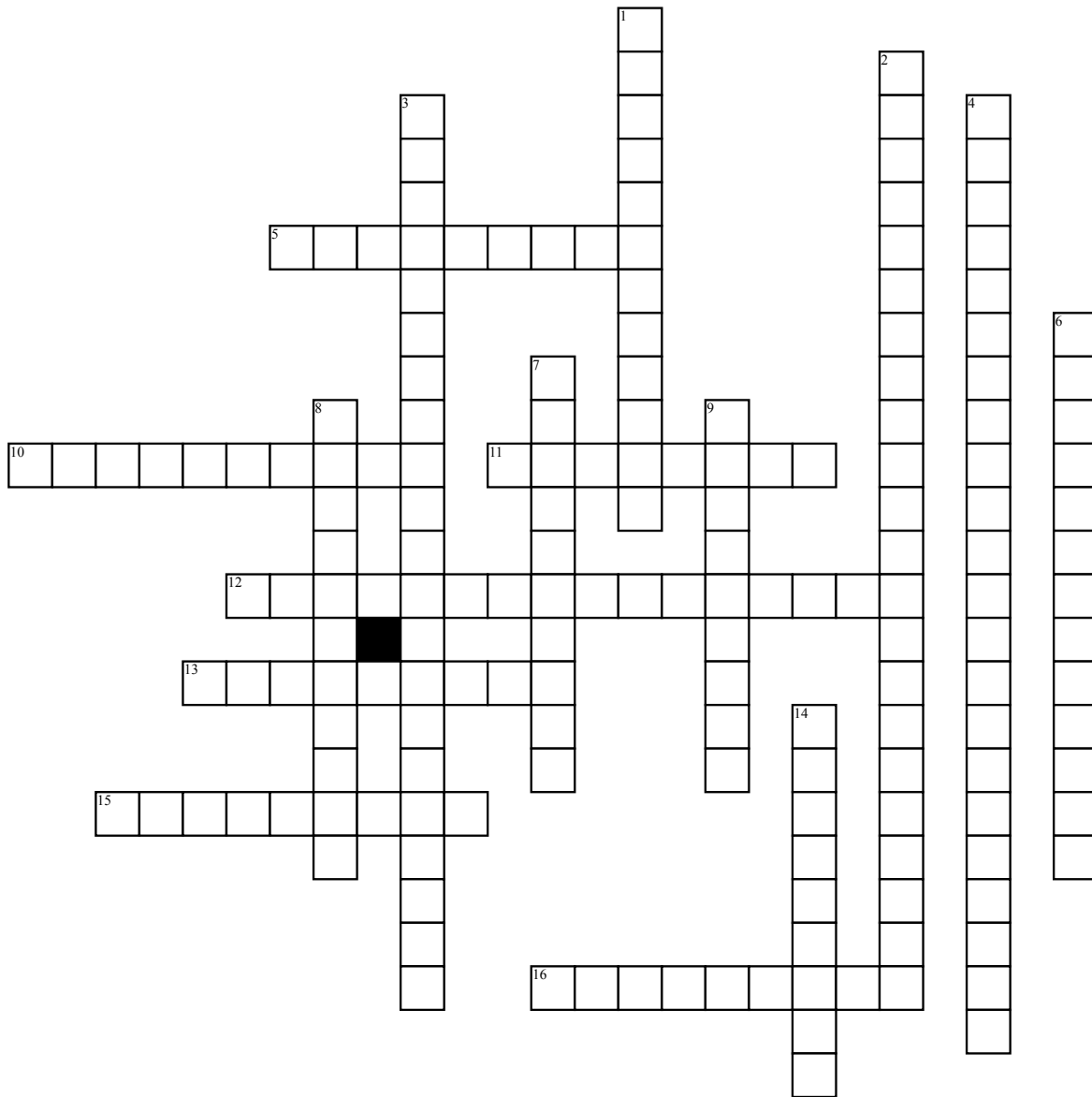


# Government Vocabulary

- 5. title often given to the head of government/chief executive and head of state in a presidential democracy; leader of a democratic government who is freely and directly elected by the citizens; directly accountable to the voters who put him/her in power; this person is separate from the legislature.
- 10. common name given to the legislative branch in a parliamentary democracy.
- 11. constitution of Germany.
- 12. A type of autocracy in which the king or queen has absolute power and the position is passed down from generation to generation; the leader inherits their power.
- 13. Having a legislature divided into two legislative houses.

- 15. A government where political authority rests with a single (one) leader; citizens do not play a role in this type of government.
  - 16. A government where power rests with the citizens; separation of power.

- 1. A type of autocracy in which one leader generally takes control by force and/or military power.
  - 2. A type of democracy where voters elect members to the nation's legislature and the parliament selects the head of government.
  - 3. A type of democracy where citizens can directly vote for the president and for the legislative branch

- 4. A form of government in which the monarch retains his/her position as head of state, while the decision-making power resides in an elected body.
- 6. A title often given to the head of the government in a parliamentary democracy.
