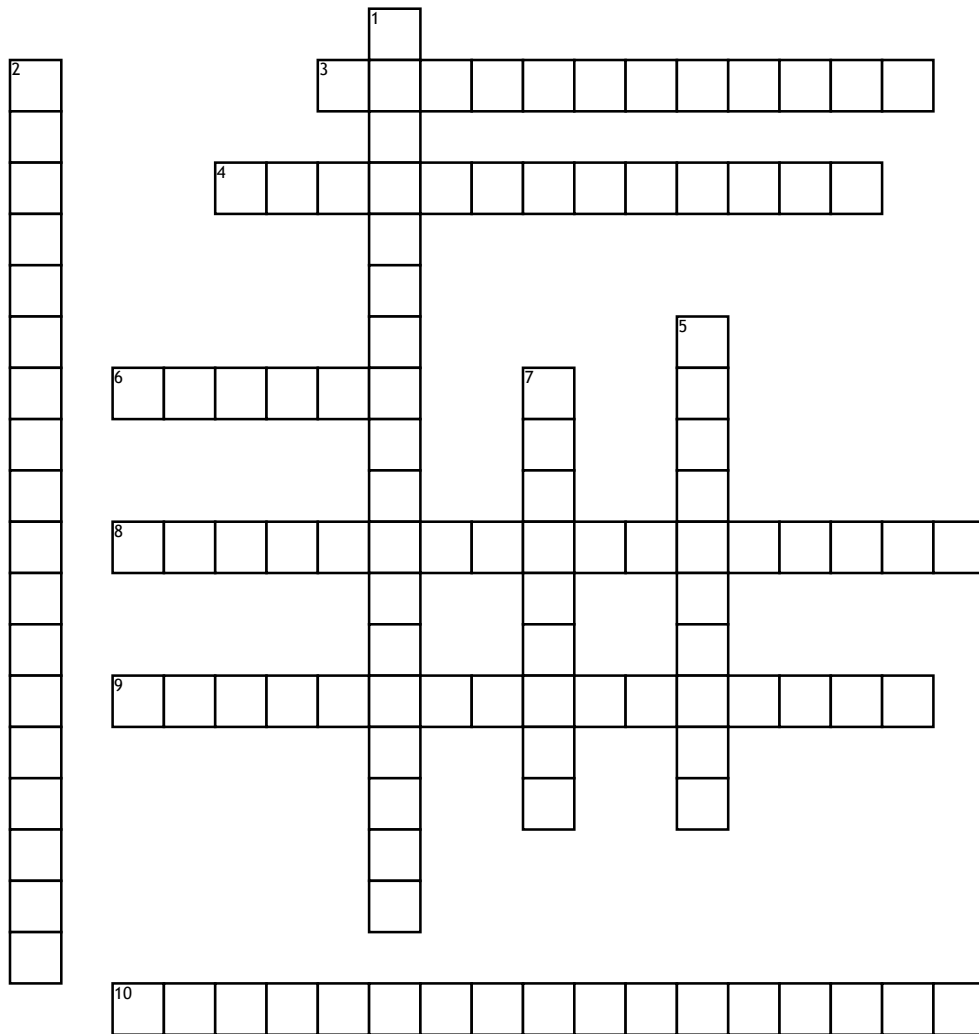

- 3. a system of beliefs and laws by which a country, state, or organization is governed
- 4. a system of government in which representatives are elected by the people to serve at the will of the people
- 6. legal, social, or ethical principles regarding what is allowed of people or owed to people
- 8. a political system in which the governing power is restricted by law and/or a constitution
- 9. liberties of each person to pursue life and goals without interference from other people or the government

- 10. principle of government under which separate branches are empowered to prevent actions by other branches and are induced to share power

- 1. idea that government is created by and subject to the will of the people
- 2. the division of legislative, executive, and judicial power within a central government
- 5. the division and sharing of power between the central and state governments
- 7. a system of government in which power is vested in the people, who rule either directly or through freely elected representatives
