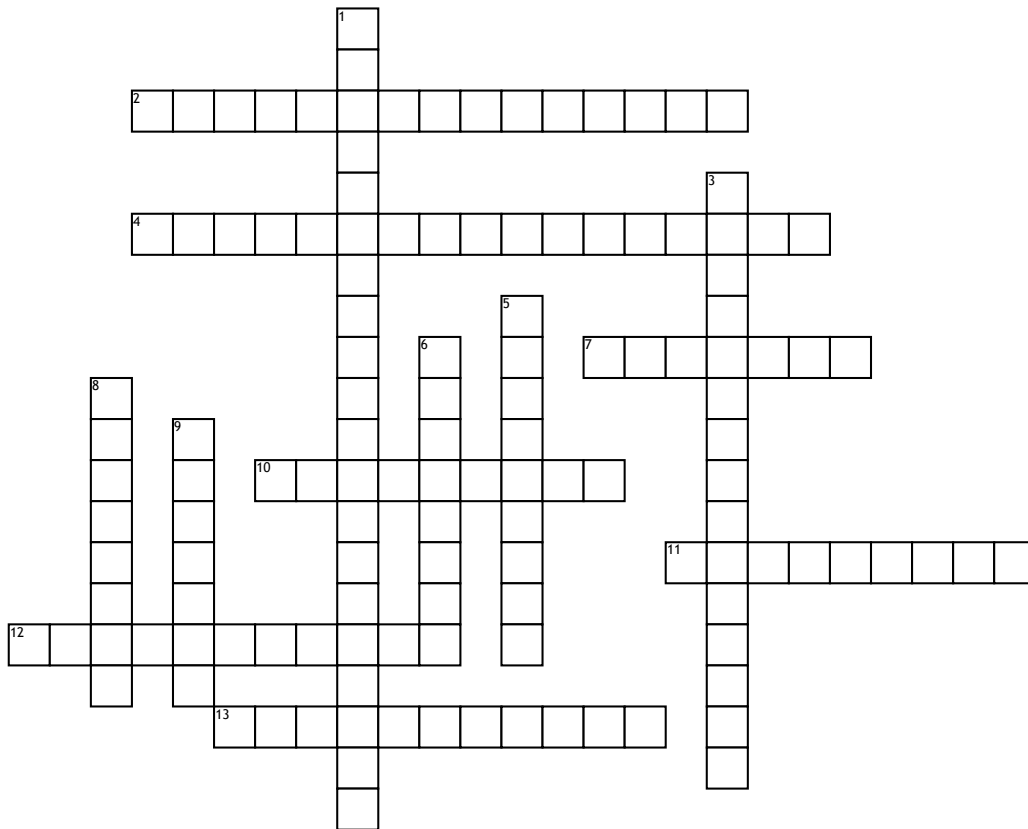


Government and Politics

- 2. All citizens participate and vote on issues
- 4. All citizens participate but they elect representatives to vote on issues
- 7. A government ruled by someone who uses power oppressively or unjustly (Assyrians)
- 10. "Government by the few", a form of government in which all power is vested in few people (Sparta)
- 11. A form of government in which god or a deity is recognized as the supreme civil ruler. (Islamic Empire)

- 12. A government or state ruled by an elite or privileged upper class (India)
- 13. A ruler or king was chosen to serve by god.

- 1. The dedication of citizens to be involved with activities that support the common good of a community above own interest.
- 3. The source of authority came from Heaven, selecting a ruler (China)

- 5. "Government by the people", a form of government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised by them (Athens)
- 6. A state or nation in which the supreme power is actually held by a single person (Egypt)
- 8. A state in which the supreme power rests in body of citizens entitled to vote and is exercised by representatives chosen directly or indirectly by them (Rome)
- 9. A series of kings or rulers who belong to the same family
