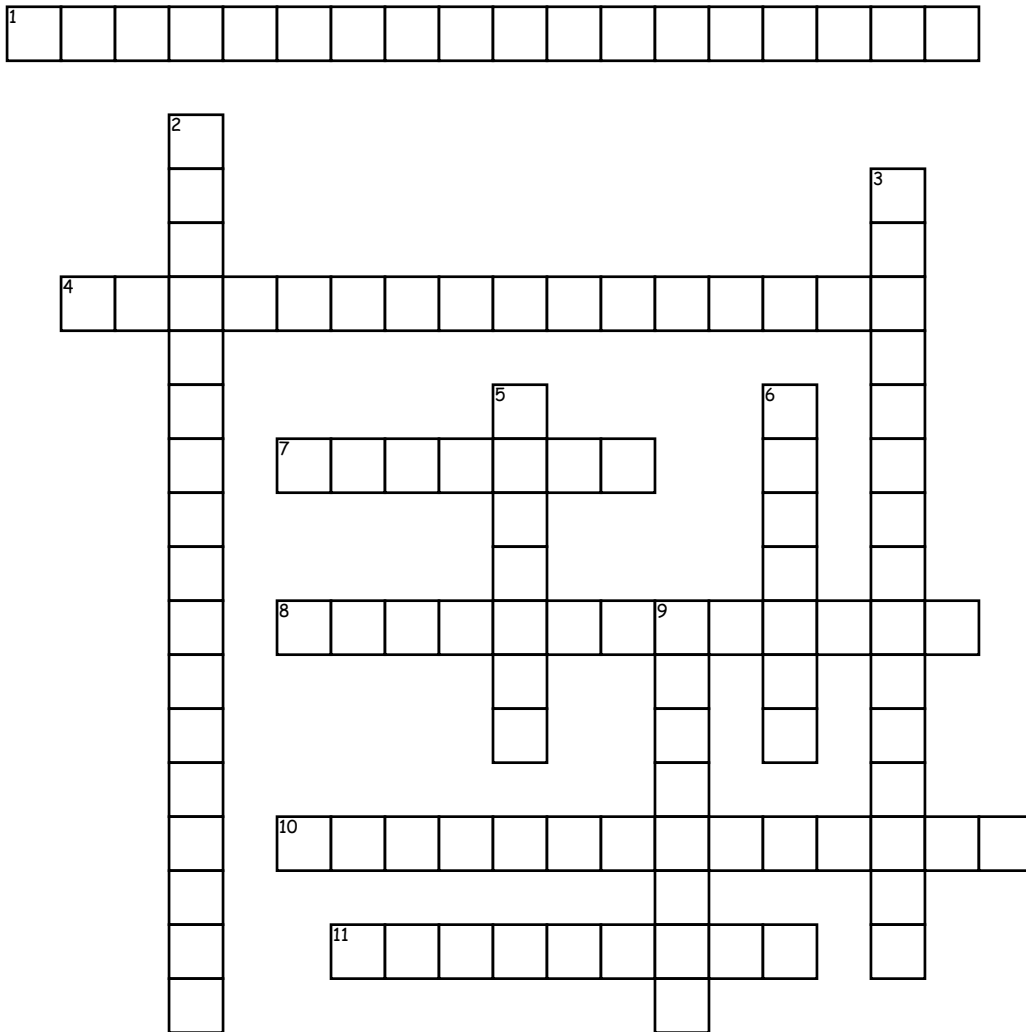


# Government
