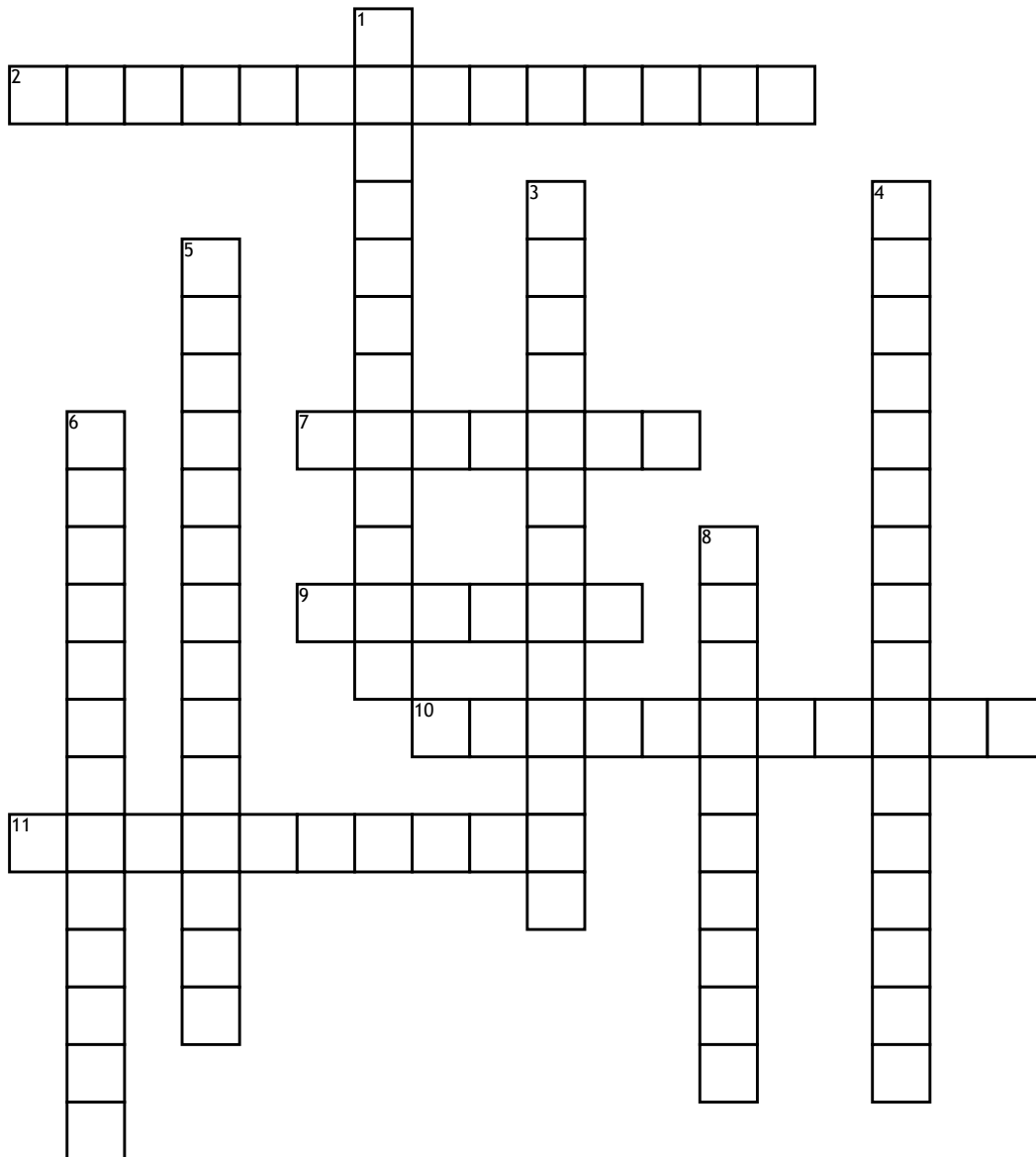


Great Depression
