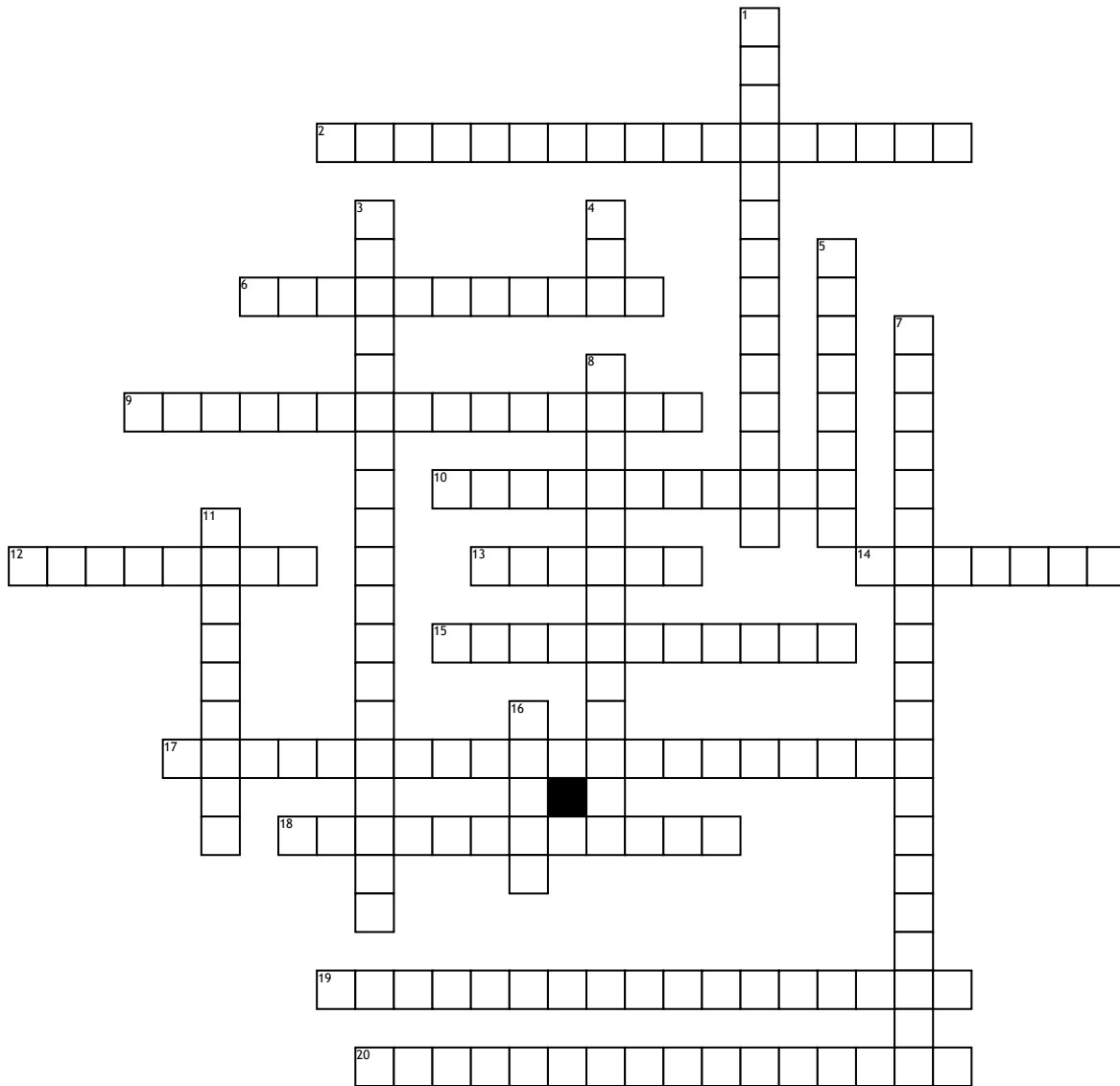


Great Depression Crossword

- 2. Law passed in 1935 that created a system to provide old-age insurance and unemployment compensation
- 6. when a lender takes over ownership of a property from an owner who has failed to make loan payments
- 9. the period of time from 1920-1941 in which America faced economic hard times
- 10. a jointly owned commercial enterprise (usually organized by farmers or consumers) that produces and distributes goods and services and is run for the benefit of its owners
- 12. Region of the Great Plains that experienced a drought in 1930 lasting for a decade, leaving many farmers without work or substantial wages.
