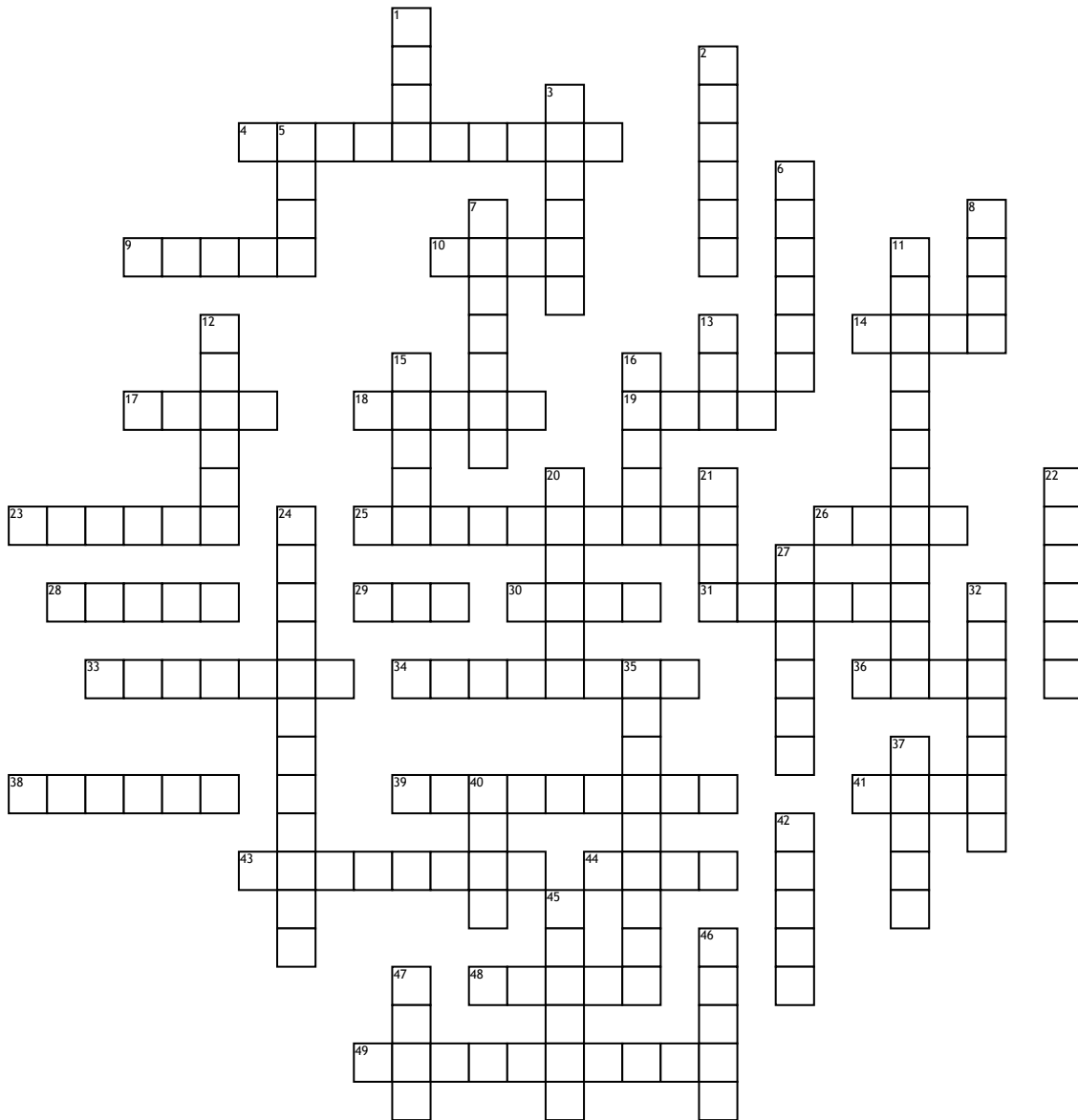


Great Expectations Crossword
