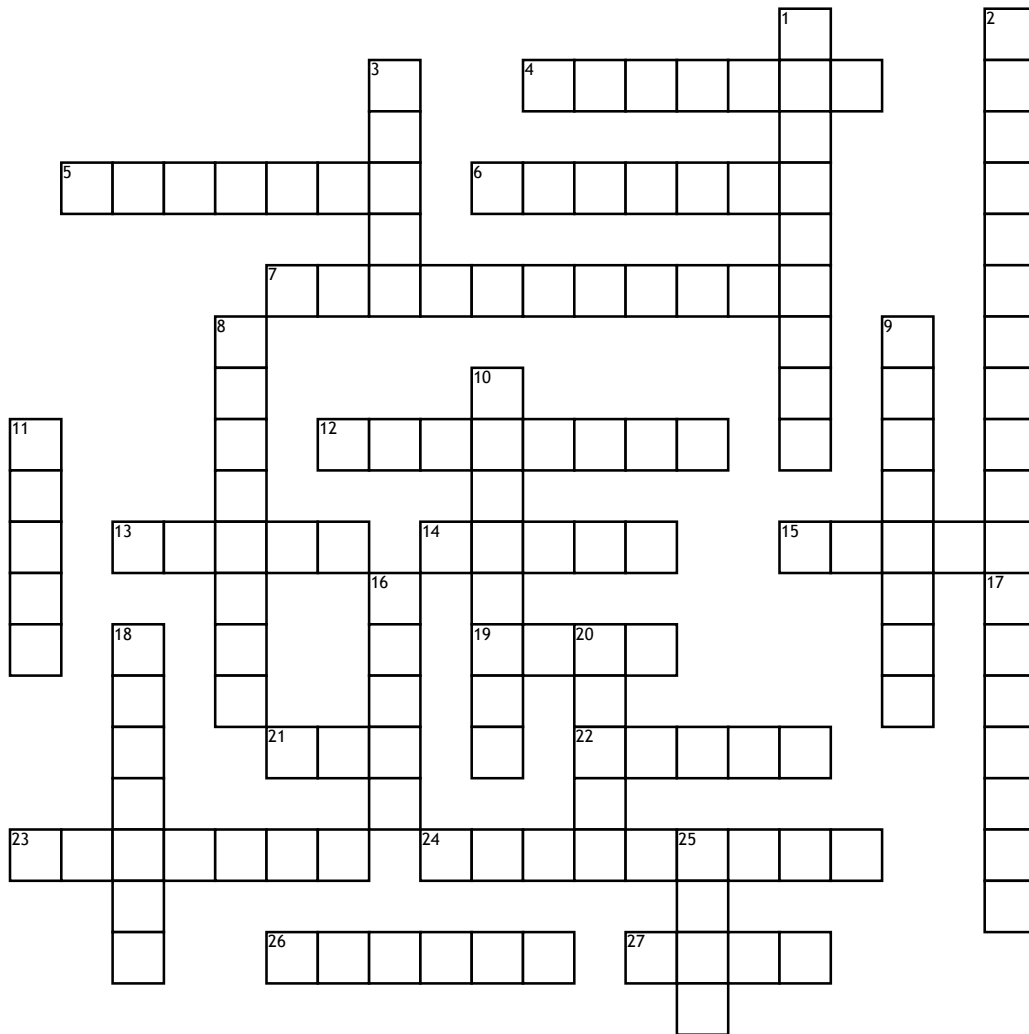


Greek Crossword Puzzle
